

## Common surgical procedures

- 2. Surgical removal of hemorrhoids, distended veins in the lower rectum or
- 4. Cervix is dilated so that the cervical canal and uterine lining can be scraped with a curette.
- 7. Surgically removal to detach the peritoneum.
- **12.** Removal of all or part of the breast.
- 13. Causes abnormal development of the backbone, stress on the back, injury, or a physical disorder.
- 15. Removal of all or part of the prostate gland.
- 16. Removal of part of the large intestine.
- 17. Removal of one or both tonsils.

- **18.** Diagnosstic test involving the removal of tissue or cells for examination under a microscope. This procedure is also used to remove abnormal breast tissue.
- 19. Protrusions of part of the intestine into the muscles of the groin
- **20.** Surgical procedure to remove blockage from carotid arteries.

- 1. Surgical delivery of a baby by an incision through the mother's abdomen.
- 3. Detaching healthy skin from one part of the body to repair others
- 5. Surgical removal of foreign material and dead, damaged, or infected tissues from a wound or burn.

- **6.** A bypass is created by grafting a price of a vein above and below the blocked area of a coronary artery, enabling blood to flow around the obstruction.
- **8.** Surgical removal of the gallbladder.
- 9. Surgical removal of a women's
- 10. Cloud the normally clear lens of the eyes. Removal of the cloudy contents with ultralight sound waves.
- 11. Surgical removal of the appendix, a small tube that branches off the large intestine, to treat acute appendicitis.
- **14.** Surgical procedure used to help diagnose and treat many uterine disorders.
