

- **8.** Disease produced by infection of Toxoplasma gondii parasite and spread through contaminated litter or cat feces.
- **9.** Is a fungal skin disease that shows up as round, scaly, encrusted lesions on the skin, hair may be lost.
- **10.** A tick-transmitted bacterial disease that results in a rash, distinctive skin lesion, hives and flu-like symptoms.
