
WW1 cross word puzzle

- 4. Strategy based on wearing down the other side with constntattacks and heavy losses.
- 7. Agreement made by opposing sides in a war to stop fighting for a certain time; a truce.
- 11. Five seeparate agreements with the defeated nations of Germany, Austria, Hungary, Bulgaria, and Turkey
- 13. The reliance on military strength and the agressive preparation for war.
- 15. Position counting as a draw or a tie - that leaves each side without any ability to make wuccessful move.
- 16. Fighting from a ditch protected by barbed wire.

- 17. A union or association formed for mutual benefit, especially between countries or organizations.
- **18.** Involved the complete mobilization of people and resources, affecting the lives of all citizens, even those remote from the battlefield.
