
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Blood Unit Crossword Puzzle

- **2.** A pattern containing spurts that resulted from blood exiting under pressure from an arterial injury
- **12.** Pointed or elongated stains which radiate away from the central area of a blood stain
- **13.** Blood spatter that travels away from the source in the same direction as the source that caused the spatter
- **14.** A pattern created when an object moves through an existing stain
- **15.** An impact spatter created by a force traveling at 5 feet or less

<u>Down</u>

- 1. The area on a two-dimensional plane where the lines traced through the long axis of several individual blood stains meet
- **3.** Blood drops created by the force of gravity acting alone
- **4.** The location in a three-dimensional space from which blood that produces a bloodstain originated
- **5.** A pattern formed by the movement of small or large amounts of blood as a result of gravity's pull
- **6.** The angle formed between the path of a blood drop and the surface that it contacts

- 7. A bloodstain pattern produced when an object makes forceful contact with a source of blood, projecting drops of blood outward from a the source
- **8.** The transfer of blood from a moving surface onto an unstained surface
- **9.** A pattern created when a surface that carries wet blood comes in contact with a second surface
- **10.** A pattern created when blood is flung from a bloody object in motion to a surface
- 11. An area within a deposited spatter that is clear of spatter, caused by an object or person blocking the area
