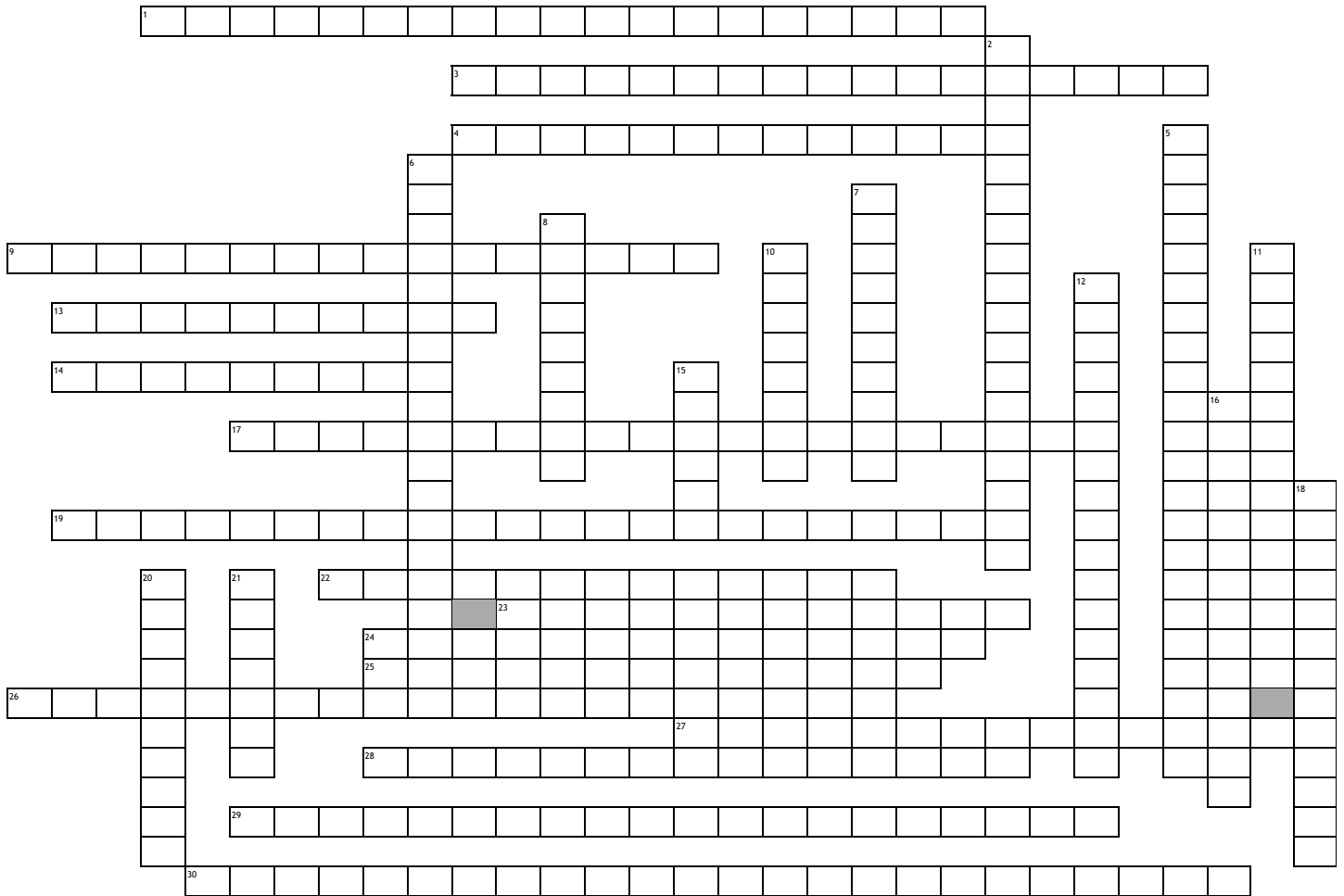

- abolished slavery
- naval engagement at Hampton Roads, Virginia
- Commanding General of Union, 18th President
- Robert E. Lee's greatest victory
- first "battle" of the Civil War
- radical abolitionist who led raid on Harper's Ferry
- occured immediately after and was due to Lincoln being elected president
- led the "March to the Sea"
- Became president aftr Lincoln's assassination
- used to review the legality of a person's arrest
- president of the Confederacy
- largest Confederate military prison
- violent disturbances in lower Manhattan due to working-class discontent
- killed Lincoln
- Supreme Court ruling involving trials
- Last engagement of Civil War
- executive order issued by Lincoln in 1863

Down

- granted African American men the right to vote
- one of the South's most successful generals
- granted newly-freed slaves citizenship
- Comanded Confederate army of North Virginia
- essentially split Confederacy in two, allowed Union control of the Mississippi
- AKA Battle of Sharpsburg, Union Victory
- Organized the army of the Potomac
- famous speech by Lincoln
- Major battle fought in Southwestern Tennessee, Union Victory
- Killed in a theater
- AKA "The Savannah Campaign", conducted through Georgia
- battle that served as a turning point
- First major battle of Civil War
