
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## Gender Inequality

- **2.** Members of early women's movements who pressed for equal voting rights for women and men.
- **3.** Social expectations about behavior deemed appropriate for the members of each sex
- **8.** The biological and anatomical differences distinguishing females from males.
- **9.** Form of feminist theory that thinks gender inequality is caused by unequal access to civil rights and certain social resources, such as education and employment, based on sex.
- **10.** The intentional killing of a newborn. Female babies are more likely than male babies to be murdered in cultures that devalue women.

**11.** The forcing of nonconsensual vaginal, oral, or anal intercourse.
