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
Weapons of World War One

<u>Across</u>

- 1. Used by submarines to blow up ships
- 7. A blade that is attached to the barrel of a rifle for use and close combat
- 8. Standard issue for all armies on the Western front to offer some protection against bullets and shell splinters
- **9.** First used to deliver bombs inspiring work but then dogfights emerged
- 10. Causes blistering skin sore eyes internal and external bleeding death could take up to five weeks
- **11.** Could shoot hundreds of rounds of ammunition per minute
- 12. A tank of nitrogen attached to a man's back that used pressure to spray fuel oil which was ignited as it left the muzzle of a small hands directed pipe

<u>Down</u>

- 2. An airship that was used during the early part of the war and bombing raids by Germans
- **3.** A short stumpy tube designed to fire a projectile at a angle so that it fell straight down on the enemy



- **4.** Protected troops from the enemy small arms fire and substantially sheltered from artillery
- **5.** Causes A burning sensation in the throat and chest painful death-suffocate
- **6.** Used to move ammunion; ridden by frontline soldiers
