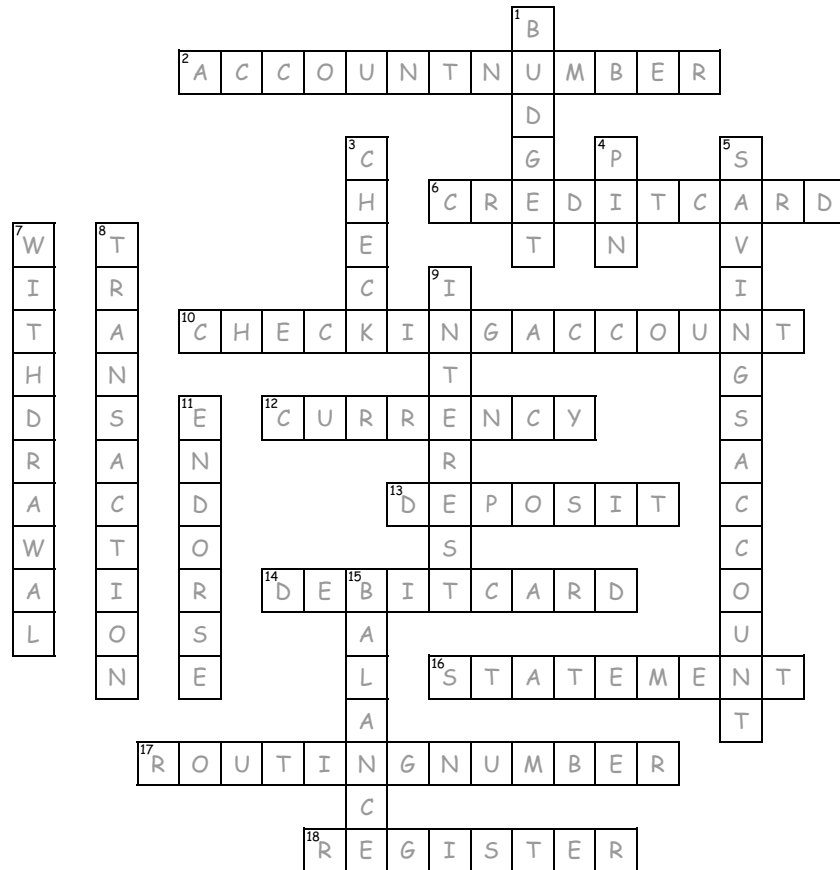


Personal Finance Vocabulary

- Number that identifies your account
- A card that allows an individual to charge the cost of a purchase to a credit account (instant loan)
- An account where money can be spent with either a debit card or checks
- Types of money
- Adding money to an account
- Works like a check where money is taken from your checking account
- A monthly report or bill from a bank or credit card company
- A number at the bottom of a check that indicates the bank it was issued from
- A record of withdrawals (checks) and deposits made into an account

Down

- A plan for spending one's money
- An order to pay money from your checking account to a person or company
- A secret code you need to be able to use an ATM
- Money set aside in a bank that earns interest
- Money taken out of an account
- Activity within an account, either a deposit, transfer, or withdrawal
- Money the bank pays you for keeping your money in a savings account
- To sign your name on the back of a check
- The existing amount in an account
