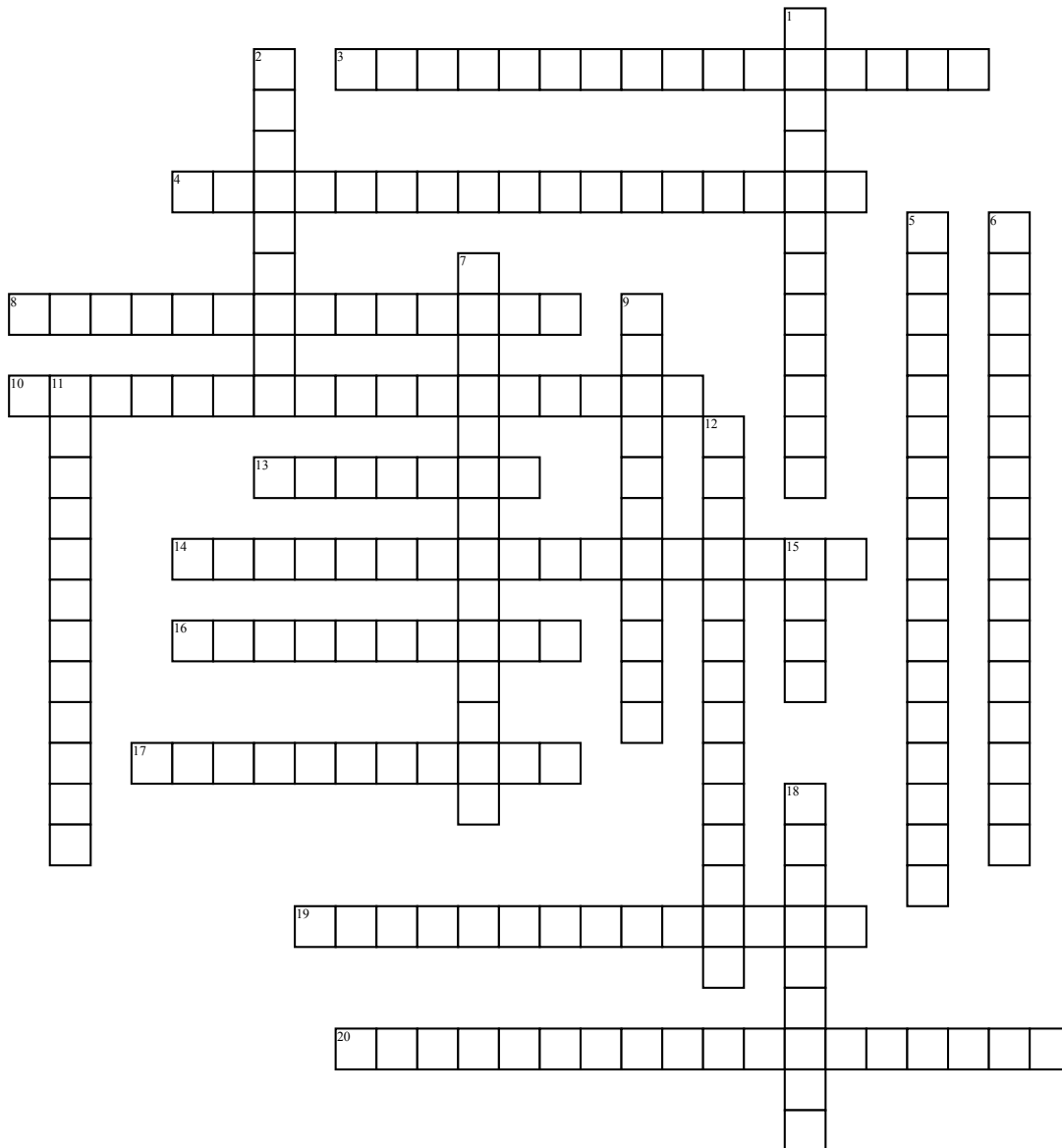


Plate Tectonics

17. solid, outer layer of earth that consists of crust and the rigid upper part of the mantle.

19. the lithosphere of the earth is divided into a small number of plates which float on and travel independently over the mantle and much of the earth's seismic activity occurs at the boundaries of these plates.
