
## Sacred Objects

- **8.** the "tablecloth" put on the altar during Mass
- **12.** A symbol of our prayers rising up to God
- **14.** object used when incense is burning; lets the "holy smoke" fill the air
- **15.** means "thanks" or "thanksgiving" sometimes used to mean Mass
- **16.** Gospel writer whose symbol is the winged man or angel

- **17.** Rope like garment that acts as a belt
- **18.** small gold plate that holds the host
- **20.** Vessel that holds the wine
- **22.** Gospel writer whose symbol is the lion

- 1. outer garment worn by deacon at Mass
- **3.** sacred linen used to cover the chalice
- 4. means "Body of Christ"
- **5.** object that is used to display the Blessed Sacrament for adoration

- **6.** sacred linen used to clean chalice at Communion time
- 7. outer garment worn by priest at Mass
- **9.** carried in procession by deacon at Mass- used to read Gospel
- **10.** Gospel writer whose symbol is the eagle
- 11. small object used to hold incense before burning
- **13.** garment worn around the neck by priest, across chest by deacon
- **19.** Gospel writer whose symbol is the ox
- **21.** white garment worn by priests, deacons and servers
