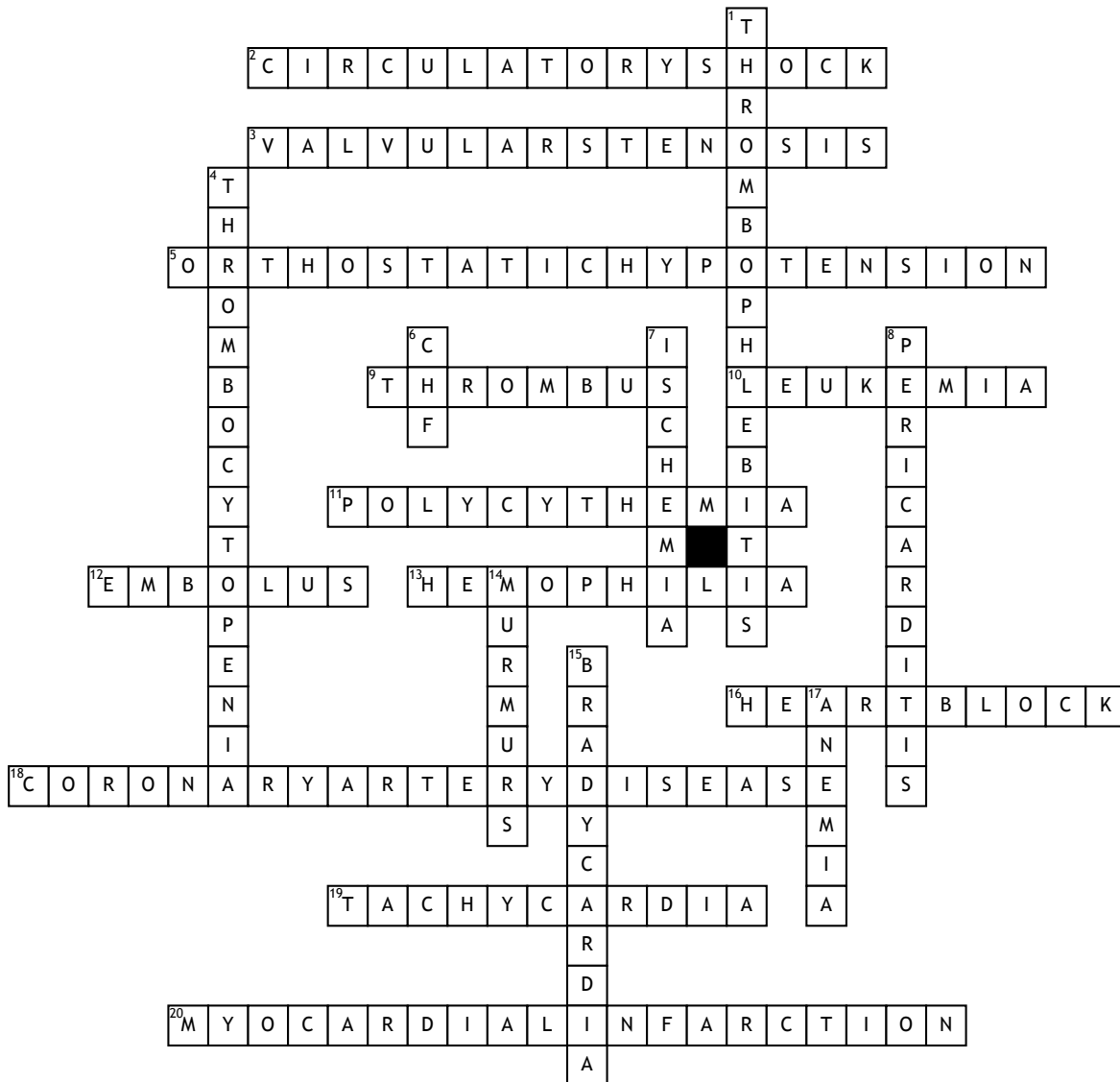


Blood and cardio disorders
