

- 4. Democratic form of government in which the party with the greatest representation in the parliament forms the government, its leader becoming prime minister or chancellor.
- 7. The total value of goods produced and services provided in a country during one year.
- 10. A form of government run by a small number of people such as wealthy landowners, royalty or powerful military figures.
- 12. Materials or substances such as minerals, forests, water, and fertile land that occur in nature and can be used for economic gain.
