
American Revolutionary War

5. This battle fought on April 19, 1775 when tensions had been building for many years between residents of the 13 American Colonies. About 700 British troops arrived in Lexington and came upon 77 mitiliamen that gathered on the town green. This is important because when shots were fired, eight mitiliamen lay dead and nine were wounded when the smoke became clear.

6. This was an attack on Germans on Christmas day. This battle consisted of the Princeton and Trenton. This is important because they ended up taking over 2,000 prisoners that were from Manhattan.
7. A colonial "dockhand" at the time of the tension in Boston. This person was one of the five murdered in the Boston Massacre. This is important because he was the first casualty of the American Revolution.
8. This treaty ended the American Revolution. This treaty was signed by representatives of King George III and of the United States of America. This is important because not only did they free the thirteen colonies, it also established the boundaries between the United States & Britains.
