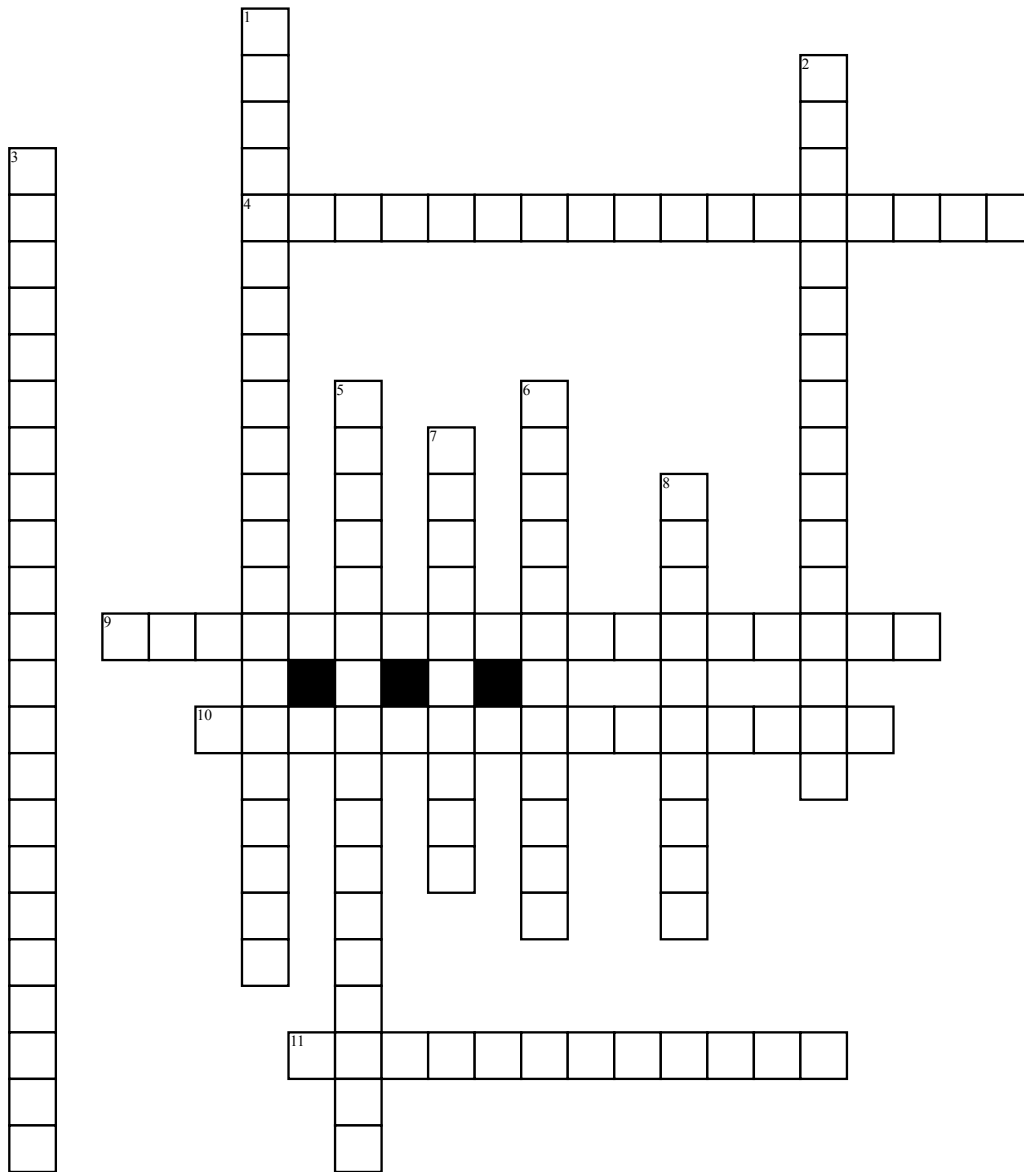


Population Dynamics

- 4.** occurs when individuals of population reproduce at constant rate
- 9.** resources that can regenerate if they are alive or can be replaced by biogeochemical cycles if they are nonliving
- 10.** as resources become less available the population growth rate slows or stops
- 11.** total of all the variety of organisms in a specific area

- 1.** resources that cannot be replenished by natural processes
- 2.** the number of organism of one species that can be supported in an environment
- 3.** a way of using natural resources without depleting them or causing long term environment harm
