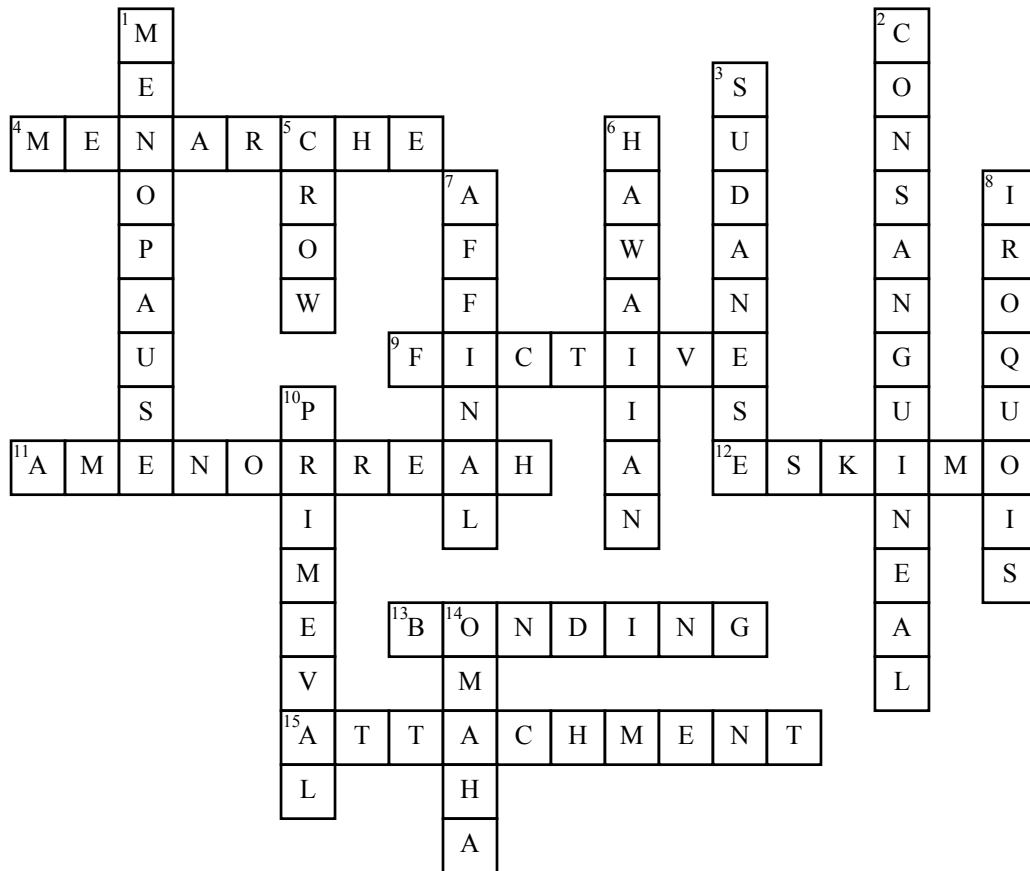


## Cultural Anthropology Unit 6 - Kinship and Reproduction



### Across

4. onset of female fertility (puberty)  
 9. kin relatives only through the role they serve  
 11. period of decreased fertility due to weaning  
 12. bilateral kinship system with generic aunt/uncle/cousin kin titles  
 13. emotional and even neurological affection of a caretaker toward a child  
 15. Continuous child expectations of nurturance from caretaker

### Down

1. natural biological end to period of female fertility  
 2. kin relatives through blood (genetic)  
 3. bilateral kinship system where each kin has unique title  
 5. Bifurcate matrilineal kinship where paternal aunt and niece share titles  
 6. Kinship system where kin titles apply to entire age grade (generation) of relative

7. kin relatives only through marriage  
 8. Matrilineal kinship system emphasizing marriage with cross cousins  
 10. The genealogical kinship expected from the natural caretaker bond suggests matrilineal monogamy  
 14. Bifurcate patrilineal kinship where maternal uncle and nephew share titles
