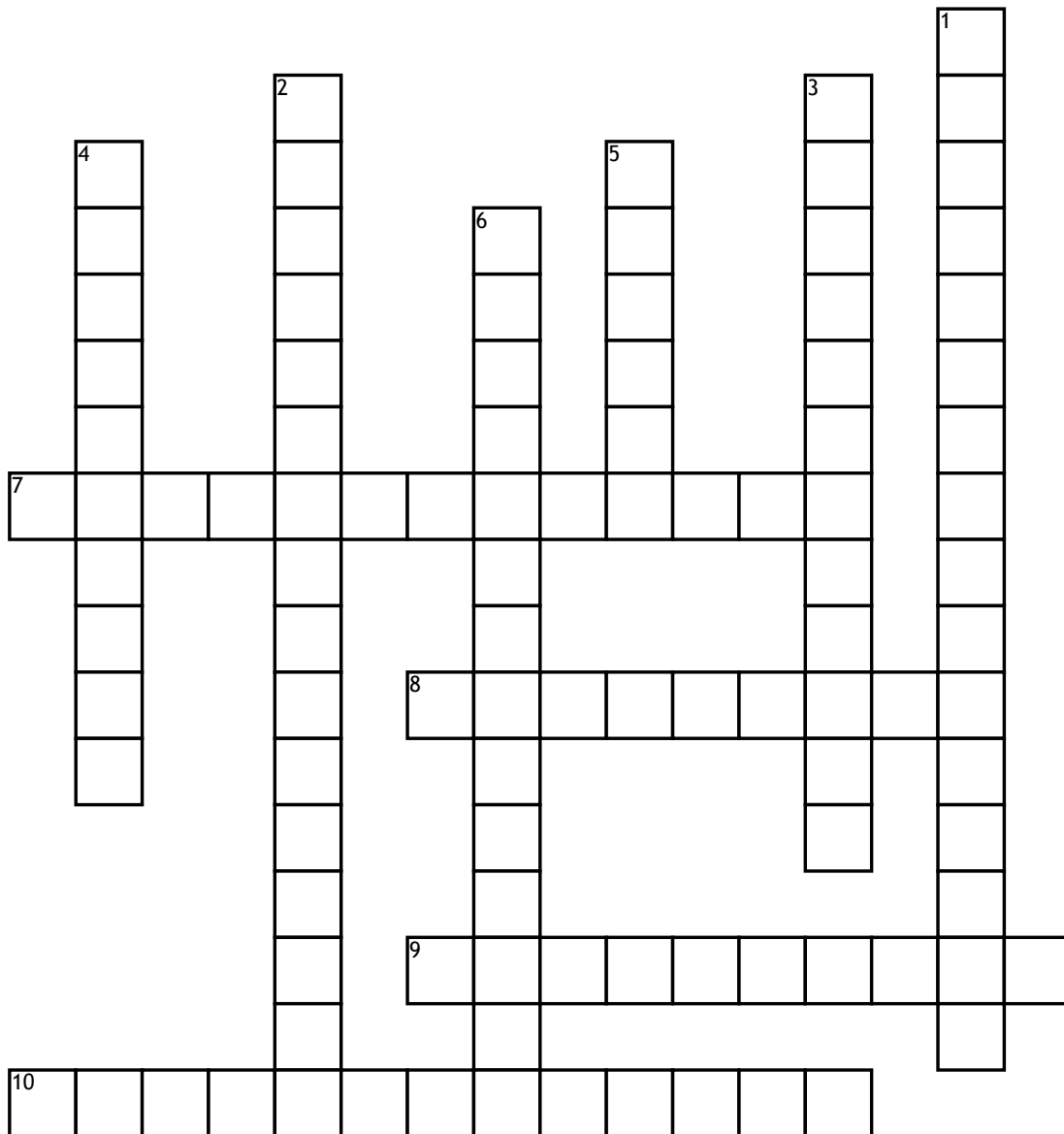

3. 1870-1940, founder of The Chicago Defender, one of the most important black newspapers in history

 6. 1797-1883, an escaped slave who was a frequent speaker on women's rights and abolition
