


SIERRA + CALEB'S BABY #2 CROSSWORD PUZZLE



ACROSS

2. A CHAIR MOUNTED ON ROCKERS OR SPRINGS, SO AS TO ROCK BACK AND FORTH.

6. THE ACTION OF FEEDING A BABY WITH MILK FROM THE BREAST
11. A SET OF CLOTHING, LINENS, AND SOMETIMES TOILETRIES FOR A NEWBORN CHILD
14. A QUIET, GENTLE SONG SUNG TO SEND A CHILD TO SLEEP
18. A CHAIR ON WHEELS, TYPICALLY FOLDING, IN WHICH A BABY OR YOUNG CHILD CAN BE PUSHED ALONG
20. THE SURGICAL DELIVERY OF A BABY THROUGH A CUT (INCISION) MADE IN THE MOTHER'S ABDOMEN AND UTERUS
23. SOMETHING YOU HANG OVER A CRIB TO ENTERTAIN THE BABY
24. A CONTAINER FITTED WITH A NIPPLE FOR GIVING MILK AND OTHER DRINKS TO BABIES AND VERY YOUNG CHILDREN
25. SEVERE, OFTEN FLUCTUATING PAIN IN THE ABDOMEN CAUSED BY INTESTINAL GAS OR OBSTRUCTION IN THE INTESTINES AND SUFFERED ESPECIALLY BY BABIES

26. A RUBBER OR PLASTIC NIPPLE FOR A BABY TO SUCK ON.

27. CHILDBIRTH

28. A PIECE OF ABSORBENT MATERIAL WRAPPED AROUND A BABY'S BOTTOM AND BETWEEN ITS LEGS TO ABSORB AND RETAIN WASTE

29. A CLOTH DEVICE THAT IS USUALLY ADJUSTABLE IN LENGTH AND THAT IS USED FOR CARRYING AN INFANT SECURELY AGAINST THE WEARER'S BODY

30. A STROLLER FOR A BABY OR YOUNG CHILD.

31. AN ANAESTHETIC USED ESPECIALLY IN CHILDBIRTH TO PRODUCE LOSS OF SENSATION BELOW THE WAIST

9. THE BIRD AS THE PRETENDED BRINGER OF BABIES

10. A DEVICE FOR KEEPING THE ATMOSPHERE MOIST IN A ROOM

12. A MEDICAL PRACTITIONER SPECIALIZING IN CHILDREN AND THEIR DISEASES

13. A DISPOSABLE CLOTH TREATED WITH A CLEANSING AGENT, FOR WIPING THINGS CLEAN

15. AN OBJECT DESIGNED FOR A BABY TO BITE ON DURING TEETHING.

16. AN INFANT'S ONE-PIECE CLOSE-FITTING LIGHTWEIGHT GARMENT, USUALLY HAVING SLEEVES BUT LEAVING THE LEGS UNCOVERED AND FASTENING WITH SNAPS AT THE CROTCH.

17. A SOFT SHOE, TYPICALLY A KNITTED ONE WORN BY A BABY.
