2. a group of (typically three or more) notes sounded together, as a basis of harmony.
5. a sequence of single notes that is musically satisfying; a tune. Often the more noticed and focused on piece of music
6. a continually repeated musical phrase or rhythm.
9. the louds and softs of a piece of music and the volume of a piece, for example forte (loud) and piano (soft)
10. a bass part in 4/4 time in which a note is played on each beat of the bar and which typically moves up and down the scale in small steps.

1. the combination of simultaneously sounded musical notes to produce a pleasing effect.
3. a short theme, usually in the bass, which is constantly repeated as the other parts of the music vary.
4. Often the density and different layers of a piece of music
7. the speed at which a piece of music should be or is played
8. displace the beats or accents in (music or a rhythm) so that strong beats become weak and vice versa.
