

- **2.** a group of (typically three or more) notes sounded together, as a basis of harmony.
- **5.** a sequence of single notes that is musically satisfying; a tune. Often the more noticed and focused on piece of music
- **6.** a continually repeated musical phrase or rhythm.
- **9.** the louds and softs of a piece of music and the volume of a piece, for example forte (loud) and piano (soft)
- **10.** a bass part in 4/4 time in which a note is played on each beat of the bar and which typically moves up and down the scale in small steps.

- 1. the combination of simultaneously sounded musical notes to produce a pleasing effect.
- **3.** a short theme, usually in the bass, which is constantly repeated as the other parts of the music vary.
