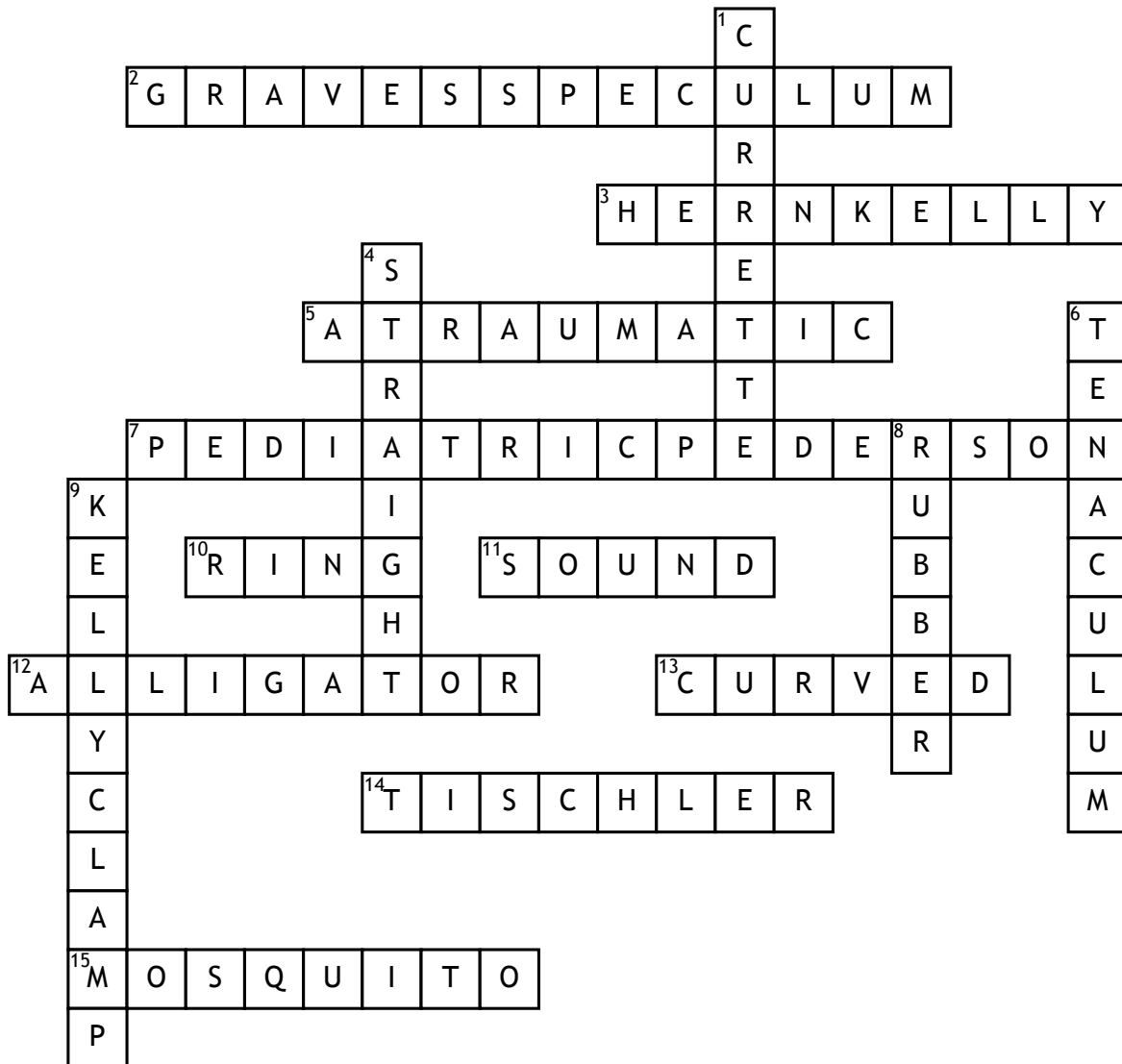


# Instruments

3. Look like ring forceps, but have a slight curve at the top
5. Type of tenaculum used in 2nd-tri AB procedures
7. Smallest speculum
10. One of the forceps always stocked in GYN rooms

11. Used to measure the length of a uterus

12. Forceps with the same name as a reptile
13. One of the forceps always stocked in GYN rooms
14. The "hole puncher" for colposcopies
15. These forceps are used to remove implants

1. Sharp instrument, versions of which are used for both colposcopies and AB procedures
4. One of the forceps always stocked in GYN rooms
6. Packaged in a kit with scopettes and scissors
8. What LEEP instruments are coated with
