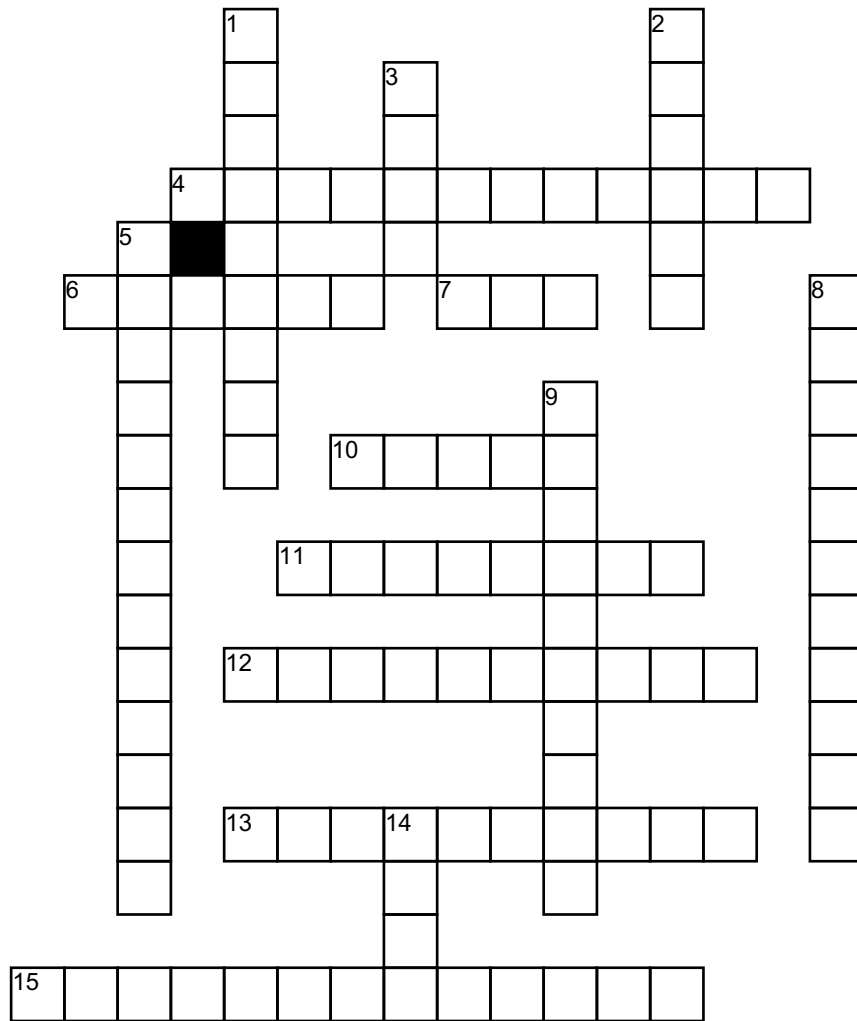


Contraception

4. Polyurethane sheath with a flexible ring at either end
