
The Rise of Russia

6. Confirmed power of tsarist autocracy by attacking authority of boyars(aristocracts)

7. Russian hier to the throne at the time of the Russian revolution

8. Ruled after assassination of her husband; accepted Western cultural influence

10. Followed death of Russian tsar Ivan IV w/o heir early in 17th century

11. Division of Polish territory among Russia, Prussia and Austria in 1772, 1793, and 1795

<u>Down</u>

1. Led by Cossack Emelian Pugachev, who claimed to be legitimate tsar

Russians who refused to accept the ecclesiastical reforms of Alexis Romanov
Peasants recruited to migrate to newly seized lands in Russia, particularly in south

4. Dynasty elected in 1614 at end of Time of Troubles

5. Prince of Duchy of Moscow

9. Son of Alexis Romanov; ruled from 1689 to 1725
