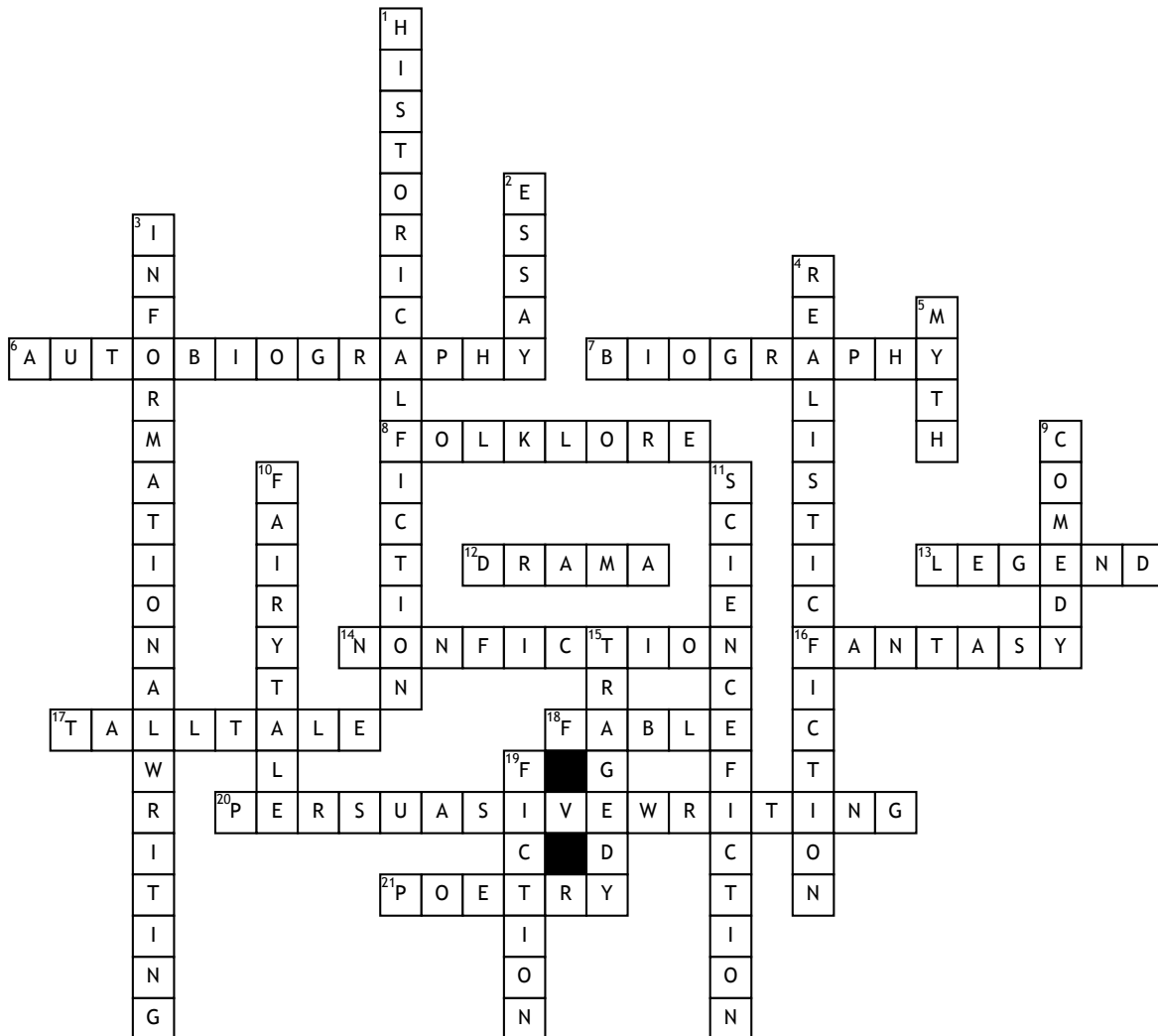


Terms Crossword Puzzle
