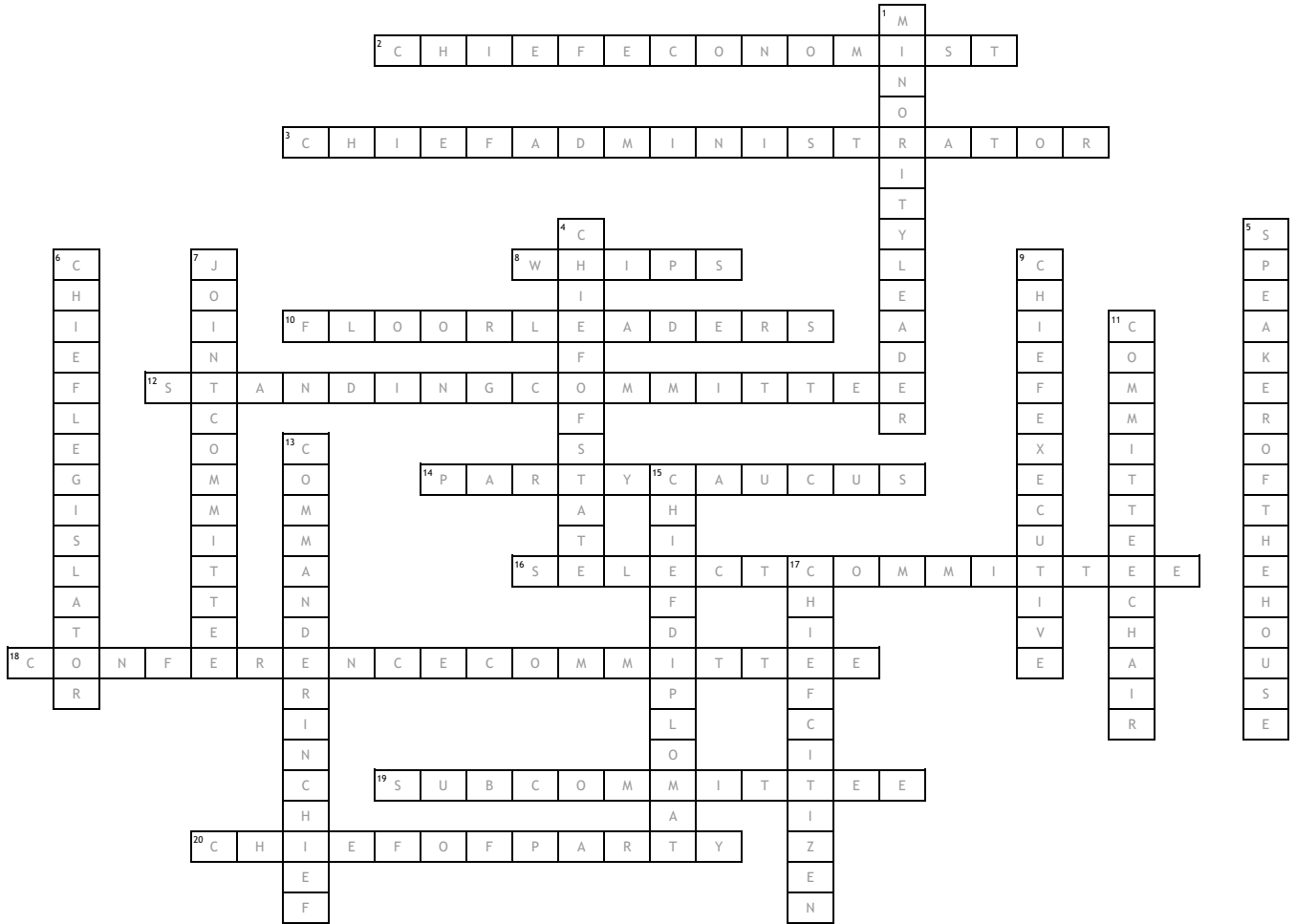


# Civics Crossword Puzzle

Term for the President as architect of Public policy and the one who sets the agenda for Congress</p> <p>7. Legislative committee composed of members of both houses</p> <p>9. Term for the President as vested with the executive power of the United States</p> <p>11. Members who heads a standing committee in a legislative body</p> <p>13. Term for the President as commander of the nation's armed forces</p> <p>15. Term of the President as the main architect of foreign policy and spokesperson to other countries</p> <p>17.
