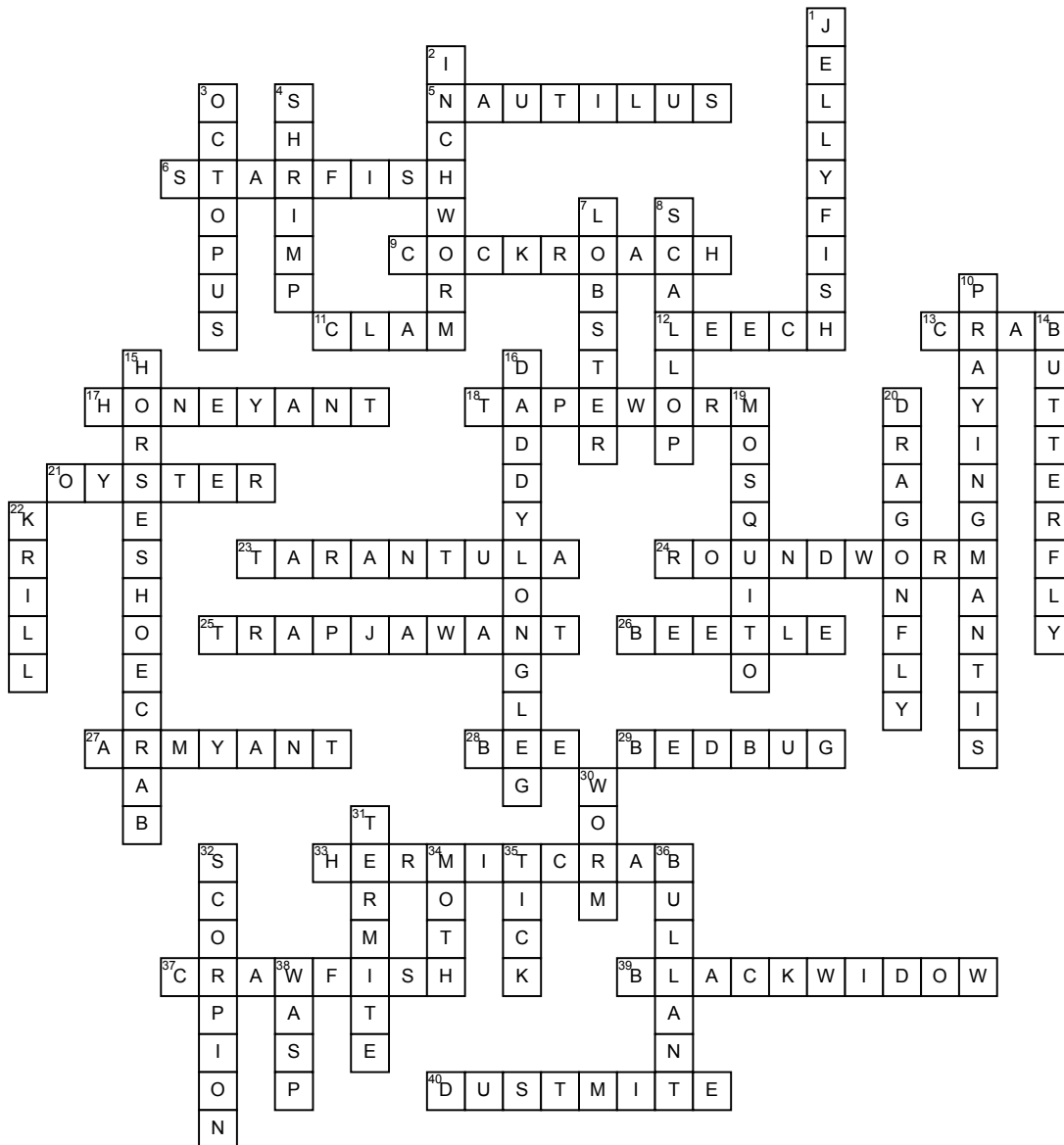


Invertebrates

5. A cephalopod mollusk with a light external spiral shell and numerous short tentacles around the mouth
6. A marine echinoderm with five or more radiating arms, feeding by scavenging
11. Marine bivalve mollusk with shells of equal size
12. Terrestrial annelid worm with sucker at both ends
13. A crustacean with a broad carapace, stalked eyes, and five pairs of legs, the first pair of which are modified as pincers
17. An ant that stores large amounts of honey dew and nectar in its elastic abdomen
18. A parasitic flatworm. Has a small head bearing hooks and suckers
21. Any number of bivalve mollusks with rough irregular shells
23. A large hairy spider
24. Parasitic worm found in the intestines of mammals. Nematode.
25. Has large, straight mandibles capable of opening 180 degrees
26. An insect of an order distinguished by forewings typically modified into hard wing cases that cover and protect the hind wings and abdomen
27. A blind and nomadic tropical ant
28. A hymenopterous insect of the superfamily Apoidea

29. A bloodsucking bug that is a parasite of birds and mammals
33. A crab with a soft asymmetrical abdomen that lives in a castoff mollusk shell for protection
37. A freshwater crayfish
39. Highly venomous spider that has a black body with red markings
40. Microscopic bug that lives in household dust

1. A free-swimming marine coelenterate that has stinging tentacles
2. Moves forward by arching and straightening its body
3. A cephalopod mollusk with eight sucker-bearing arms.
4. Small free-swimming crustacean with an elongated body.
7. Large marine crustacean, cylindrical body, stalked eyes, and 5 pincers
8. Edible bivalve mollusk with a ribbed fan-shaped shell
10. Insect that waits motionless for prey with its large spiky forelegs folded like hands in prayer
14. Insect with two pairs of large wings that are usually bright colored
15. Large marine arthropod with a domed horseshoe-shaped shell. Has ten legs.
16. An arachnid with a globular body and long thin legs
19. Slender long-legged fly with aquatic larvae

20. Fast-flying long-bodied predatory insect with two pairs of large transparent wings
22. Small shrimp like planktonic crustacean of the open sea
30. Long slender, soft body with no limbs
31. Feeds on wood. Can be highly destructive to timber and trees
32. A terrestrial arachnid with lobster like pincers and a poisonous sting at the end of its jointed tail
34. Chiefly nocturnal insect related to the butterflies
35. Lives by feeding on blood of mammals, birds, and sometimes reptiles
36. Alert ants that can grow up to 40mm long
38. A social winged insect that has a narrow waist and a sting
