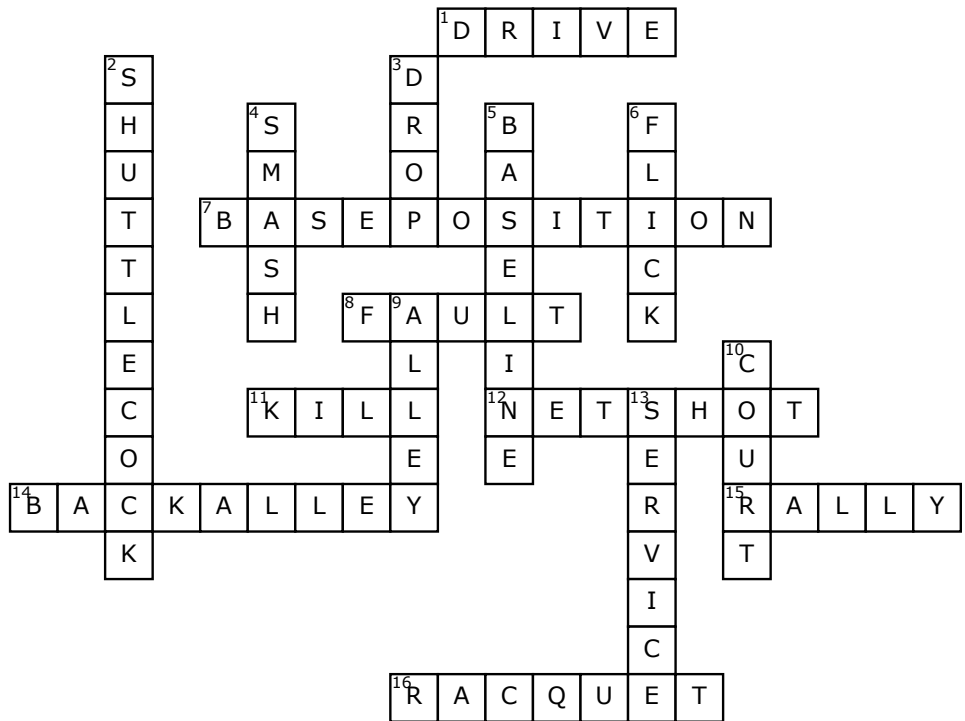


# Badminton Terminologies

## Across

- 1.** A fast and low shot that makes a horizontal flight over the net
- 7.** Location in the center of the court to which a single player tries to return after each shot
- 8.** A violation of the playing rules, either in serving, receiving, or during a play
- 11.** A fast downward shot that cannot be returned
- 12.** A Shot hit from the forecourt that just clears the net and drops sharply
- 14.** An Area between the back boundary line and the long service line for doubles
- 15.** Exchange of shots while the shuttle is in play



**16.** An instrument used by player to hit a shuttlecock

## Down

- 2.** An official name for the object that players hit most of the time
- 3.** A shot that hits slowly and with finesse to fall rapidly and close to the net on the opponent's side
- 4.** A hard hit overhead shot that forces the shuttle sharply downward
- 5.** A back boundary line at each end of the court that is parallel to the net

**6.** A quick wrist and forearm rotation that surprises an opponent by changing an apparently soft shot into a faster passing one

**9.** An Extension of the court by 1 1/2 feet on both sides for doubles play

**10.** An area of play, as defined by the outer boundary lines

**13.** Stroke used to put shuttlecock into play at the start of each rally
