

## **Badminton Terminologies**

## **Across**

- **1.** A fast and low shot that makes a horizontal flight over the net
- 7. Location in the center of the court to which a single player tries to return after each shot
- **8.** A violation of the playing rules, either in serving, receiving, or during a play
- **11.** A fast downward shot that cannot be returned
- **12.** A Shot hit from the forecourt that just clears the net and drops sharply
- **14.** An Area between the back boundary line and the long service line for doubles
- **15.** Exchange of shots while the shuttle is in play





## Down

- **2.** An official name for the object that players hit most of the time
- **3.** A shot that hits slowly and with finesse to fall rapidly and close to the net on the opponent's side
- **4.** A hard hit overhead shot that forces the shuttle sharply downward
- **5.** A back boundary line at each end of the court that is parallel to the net

- **6.** A quick wrist and forearm rotation that surprises an opponent by changing an apparently soft shot into a faster passing one
- **9.** An Extension of the court by 1 1/2 feet on both sides for doubles play
- **10.** An area of play, as defined by the outer boundary lines
- **13.** Stroke used to put shuttlecock into play at the start of each rally
