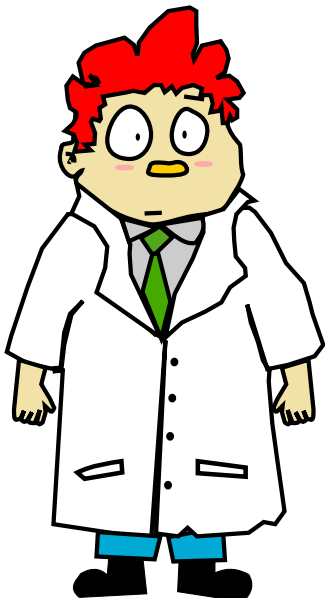
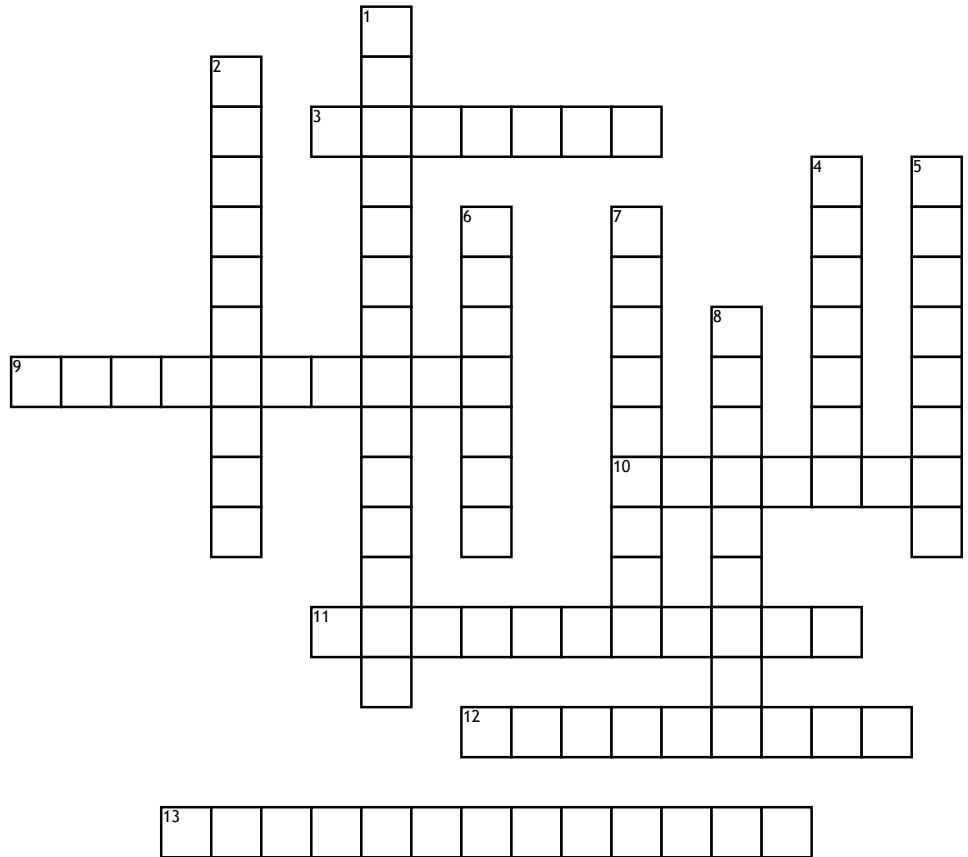
3. treatment intended to relieve or heal a disorder
