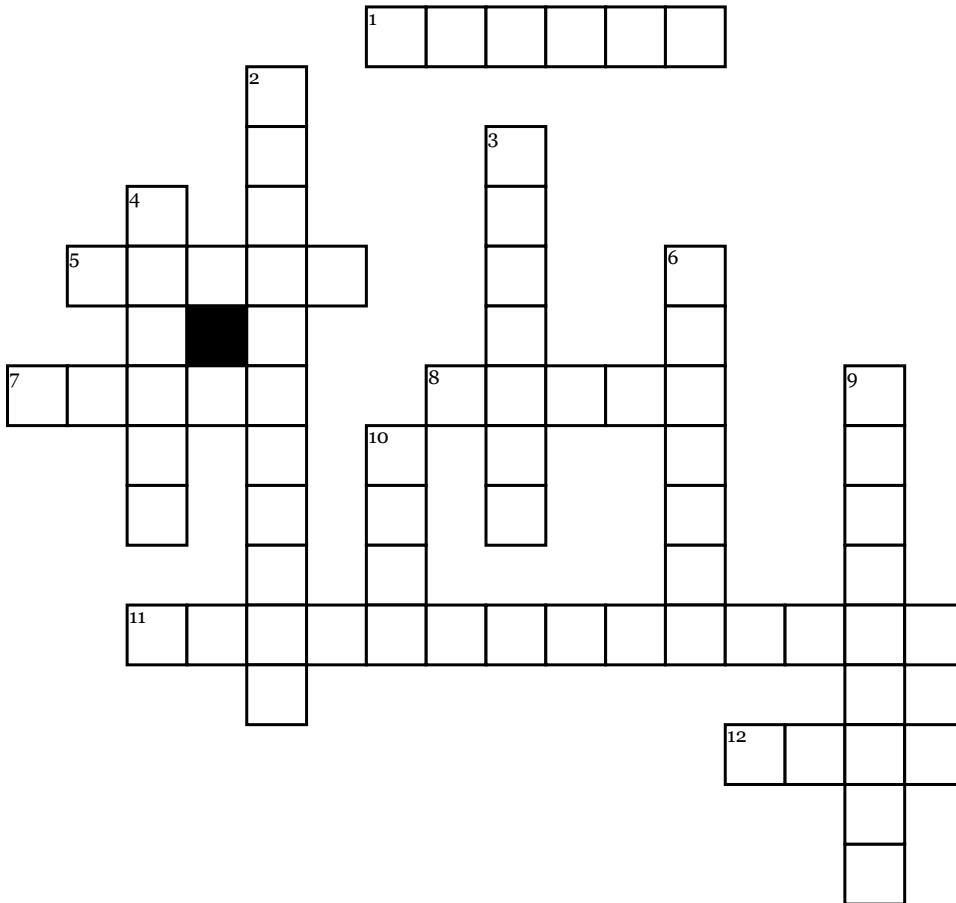


The Excretory System

1. Narrow tubes (2) that carry urine from the kidneys to the urinary bladder

5. Digestive system - makes urea and breaks down wastes into forms that can be excreted

7. Respiratory system - removes CO₂ and some water when you exhale

8. A fluid that includes urea and other wastes

11. A muscular sac that stores urine

12. Integumentary system - perspiration leaves through pores

2. Maintaining stable, internal body conditions

3. A tiny filtering factory that removes wastes from blood and produces urine

4. Major organs (2) of the excretory system that act like filters by removing urea and other waste from the blood but keep materials that the body need

6. A small tube in which urine leaves the body

10. A chemical that comes from the breakdown of proteins
