
## The Excretory System

- 1. Narrow tubes (2) that carry urine from the kidneys to the urinary bladder
- **5.** Digestive system makes urea and breaks down wastes into forms that can be excreted
- 7. Respiratory systemremoves CO2 and some water when you exhale
- **8.** A fluid that includes urea and other wastes

- **11.** A muscular sac that stores urine
- **12.** Integumentary system perspiration leaves through pores

- **3.** A tiny filtering factory that removes wastes from blood and produces urine
- 4. Major organs (2) of the excretory system that act like filters by removing urea and other waste from the blood but keep materials that the body need
