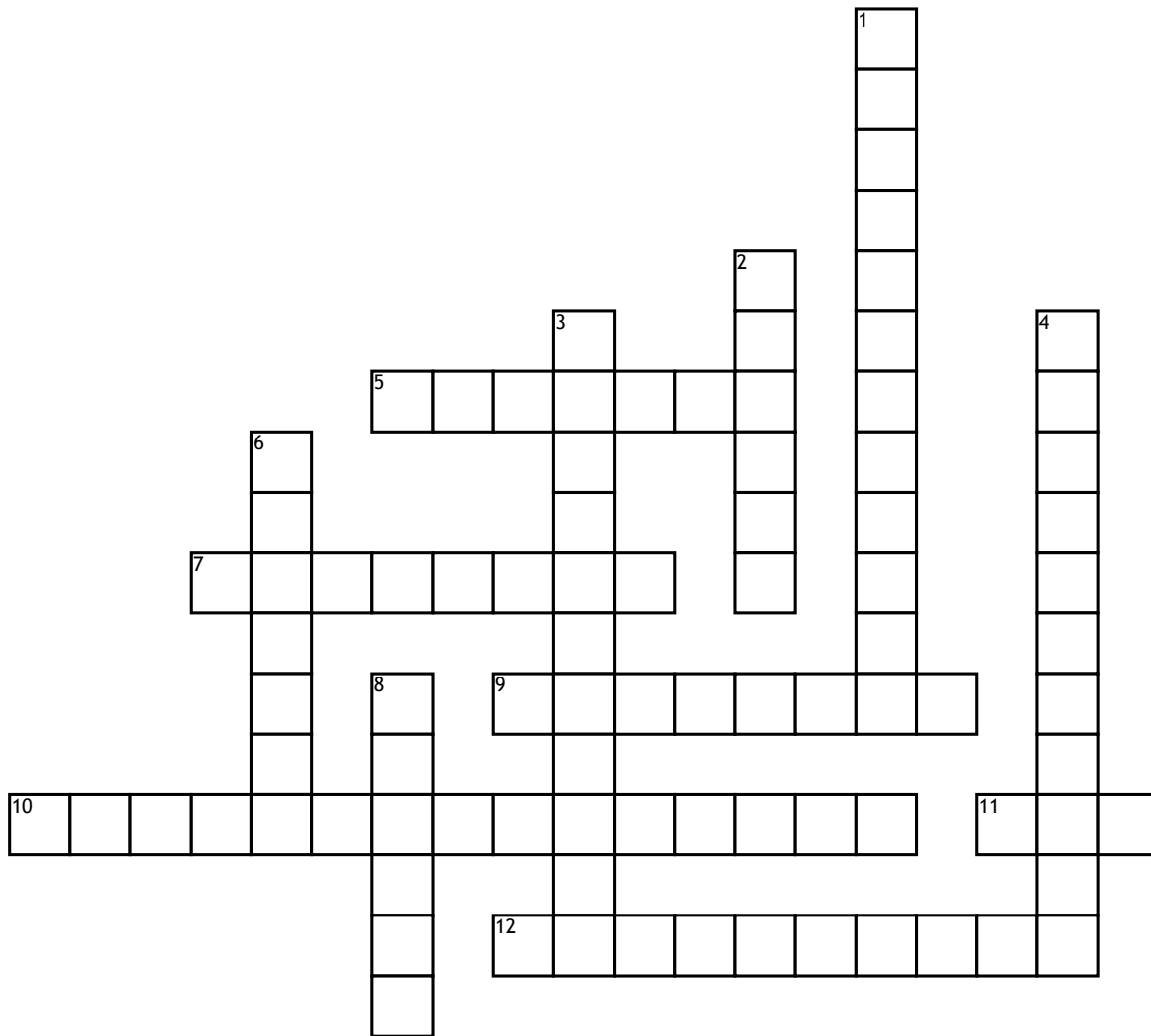


# Infection and response
