

- 3. Skin that covers the matrix
- 4. Most visible and functional part of the natural nail
- 8. Whitish half moon shape
- **10.** Area where the nail plate cells are formed
- 12. Also known as Onyx
- **14.** Tissue attached to nail plate and nail bed

- **15.** Abnormal in shape or form
- **16.** Extends over the tip of the finger
- 17. Tissue bordering the root and sides of fingernail
