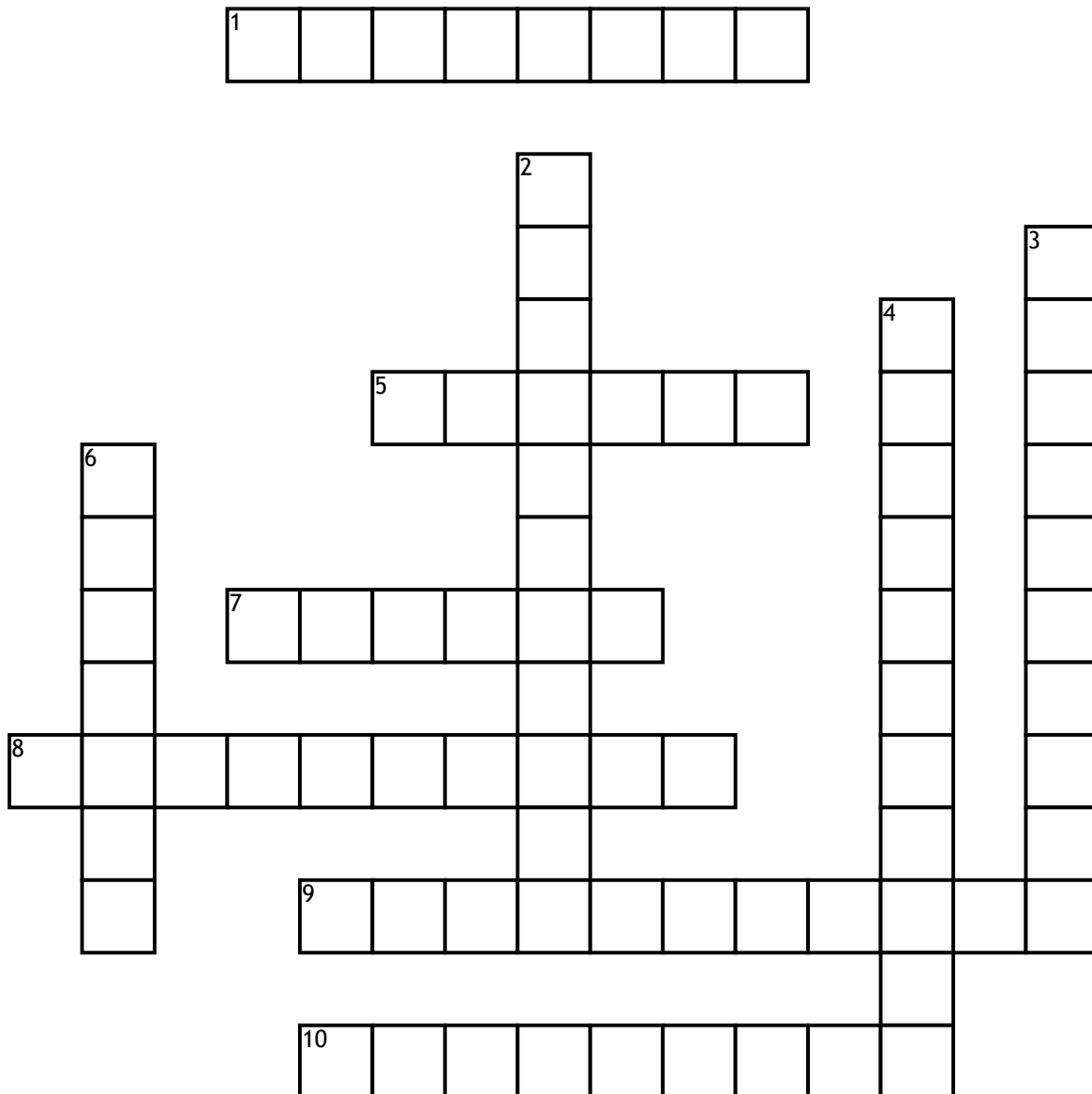

Pressure Ulcers Wound Assessment



Across

- 1. Pertaining to or consisting of pus
- 5. Necrotic tissue within wound that can be loose/stringy/adherence; grey/yellow/black
- 7. Thick necrotic tissue(dry/moist) that covers the surface of the wound
- 8. Softening of tissue due to excessive exudate or moisture
- 9. Moist tissue that is pink/red, beefy appearing with lumpy/bumpy appearance

- 10. a sinus tract or pathway extending from the wound surface in a single direction

Down

- 2. Linear scratches on skin
- 3. Firm, hard tissue
- 4. Tissue destruction underlying intact skin along wound edges; extends in several directions
- 6. Wound drainage
