
## Hearing and Balance



## <u>Across</u>

**5.** Sensation that an individual's body or surroundings are rotating

**8.** Infection or inflammation of the lining of the external ear canal

**9.** Infection of the middle ear

**10.** Hearing loss associated with aging **Down** 

## <u>Down</u>

**1.** Can be acute or chronic and is caused by the inflammation of the labyrinth

2. Accumulation of fluid in the inner ear. Can be caused by alcohol, stress and sudden movements of the head
3. Epithelial cells grow into the middle ear after the tympanic membrane is perforated

**4.** Damage to the eighth cranial nerve caused by chemicals including some drugs

**6.** Waxy secreation in the external auditory canal, earwax

**7.** Abnormal growth that causes the footplate of the stapes to become fixed
