

- **6.** Agents that widen the diameter of bronchial tubes
- **8.** Stimulates water reabsorption from nephrons
- **9.** Controls the level of blood glucose

- **12.** Used to prevent or treat excessive bleeding from surgical sites
- 14. Dilates vessels

- **16.** Used to treat osteoporosis in postmenopausal women
- **17.** Stimulates contraction of smooth muscle in the uterus
- **18.** Used to treat stable and variant angina
- **19.** Work by increasing cell calcium concentration to enhance contractility of cardiac muscle

- **1.** Decrease formation of angiotensin II
- **2.** Used to treat atrial fibrillation and flutter and ventricular tachycardia

- **3.** Used to treat severe attacks of gout

- **7.** Often used to treat asthma in children
- **10.** Used to prevent and treat osteoporosis and to reduce risk of breast cancer in postmenopausal women
