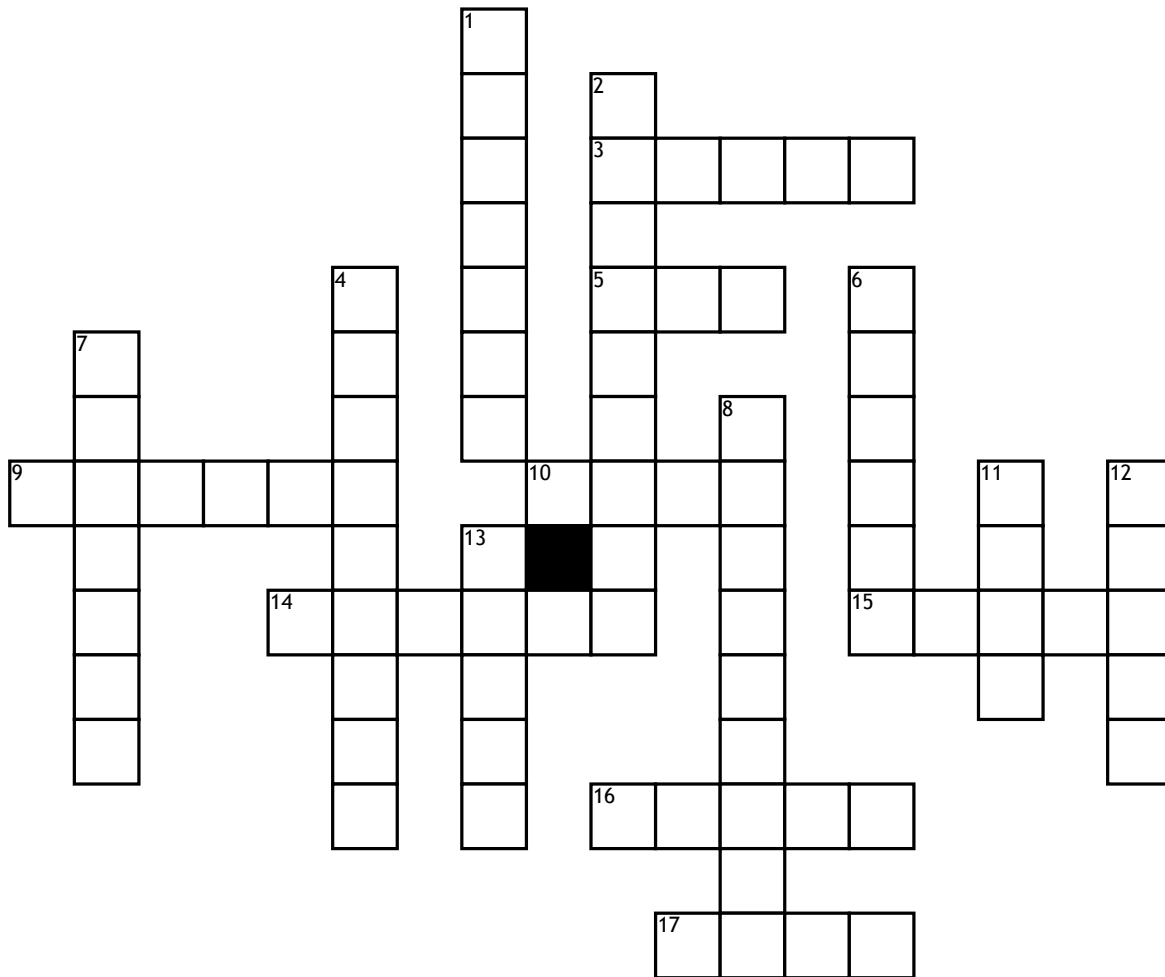

1. Narrow stretch of land connecting two larger land areas.

7. Area of flat or rolling land at high elevation, about 300 to 3,000 feet high

8. Body of land jutting into a lake or ocean, surrounded on three sides by water.

11. Part of a body of water that extends into a shoreline; larger and deeper than a bay.

12. Land along a sea or an ocean.

13. Area of level land, usually low elevation and often covered with grasses
