
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Landforms and Bodies of Water

- **3.** Large natural stream that flows through land.
- **5.** Part of a large body of water that extends into a shoreline
- **9.** A deep, narrow alley with steep walls.
- **10.** Body of water completely surrounded by land; usually freshwater.
- **14.** Low land between hill or mountains.
- **15.** Flat, low land built up from soil carried downstream by a river and deposited at its mouth.

- **16.** _____ of a river--Place where a river empties into a larger body of water.
- **17.** Point of land that extends into a river, lake, or ocean.

<u>Down</u>

- 1. Narrow stretch of land connecting two larger land areas.
- **2.** Small stream or river that flows into a larger stream or river.
- **4.** Land with steep sides that rise sharply from the surrounding land.

- **6.** Body of land completely surrounded by water.
- 7. Area of flat or rolling land at high elevation, about 300 to 3,000 feet high
- **8.** Body of land jutting into a lake or ocean, surrounded on three sides by water.
- 11. Part of a body of water that extends into a shoreline; larger and deeper than a bay.
- **12.** Land along a sea or an ocean.
- **13.** Area of level land, usually low elevation and often covered with grasses
