

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Stagecraft: Lighting and Sound



Across

- the room at the back of the auditorium used to run the lighting system
- 4. small lights located on 1st 4 electrics, used as worklights and as accents for the stage: white, red, green, blue
- **6.** steel framework above the stage for suspending all equipment, scenery, and lighting
- 11. Used to light the cyclorama, located on the 5th electric : red, green, blue
- **13.** a lighting position over the aduience

- **14.** a metal cutout place in the center of a lighting instrument to project an image
- **15.** A short light tree, used for side lighting
- 16. A color filter for lighting
- 17. these limit the part of the stage visible to the audience. sight lines affect masking, entrances, levels, and many other critical choices onstage
- **18.** lighting position on the walls of the side of the house
- **19.** cue to cue rehearsal without the cast, crew only

2. a lighting position on the stage floor, right and left

- **3.** an instruments for converting sound waves into electrical energy variations
- **5.** The source of electricity for the lighting system located in the shop
- **7.** a sudden removal of all or almost all light on stage
- **8.** the lights illuminating the audience before the production begins, can be operated from stage right or in booth
- **9.** the return to the input of a part of the output of a machine system or process
- 10. to change the intensity of lighting
- **12.** illumination provided on stage for rehearsals, setting up scenery, etc. should be cheap to operate
