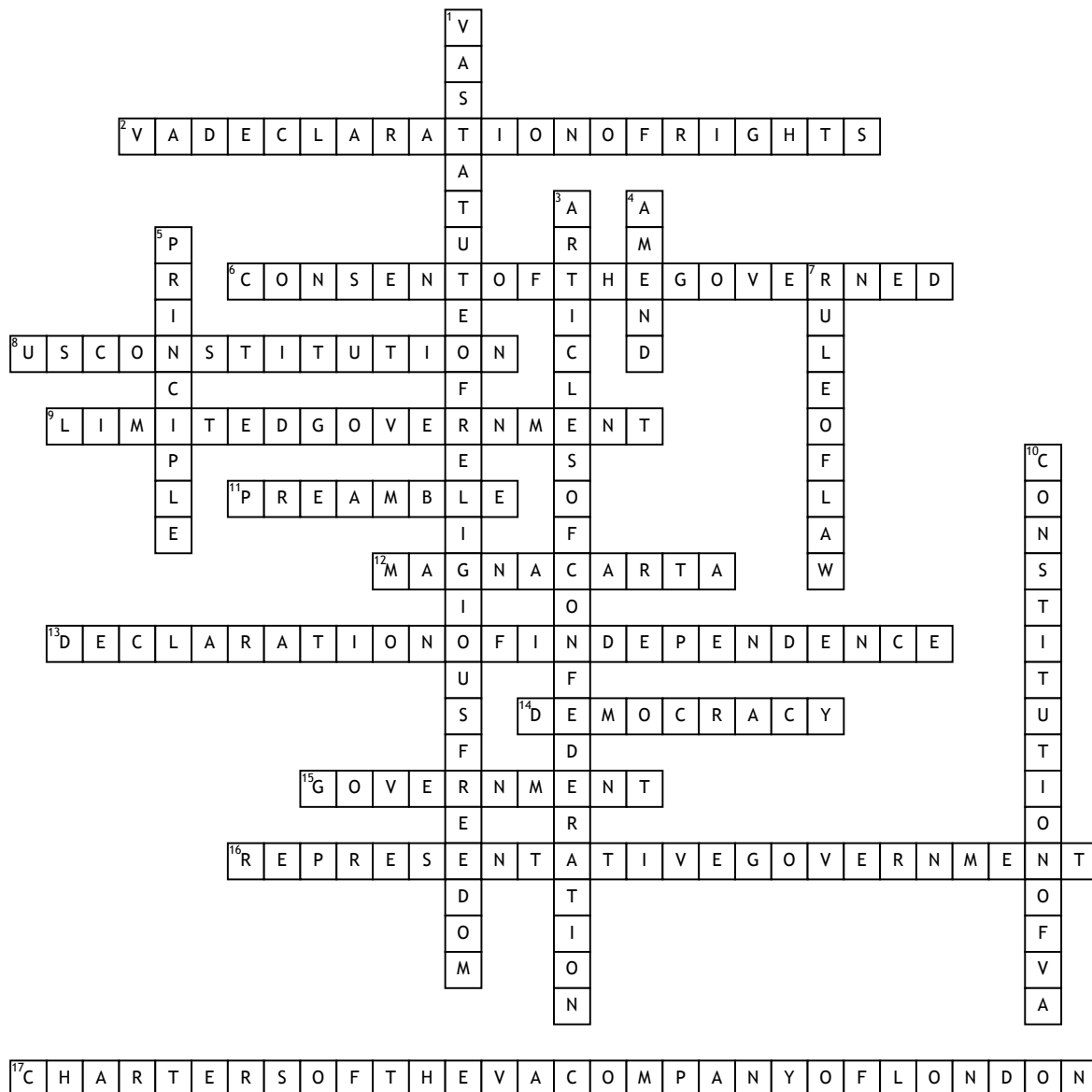


Civics Crossword Puzzle
