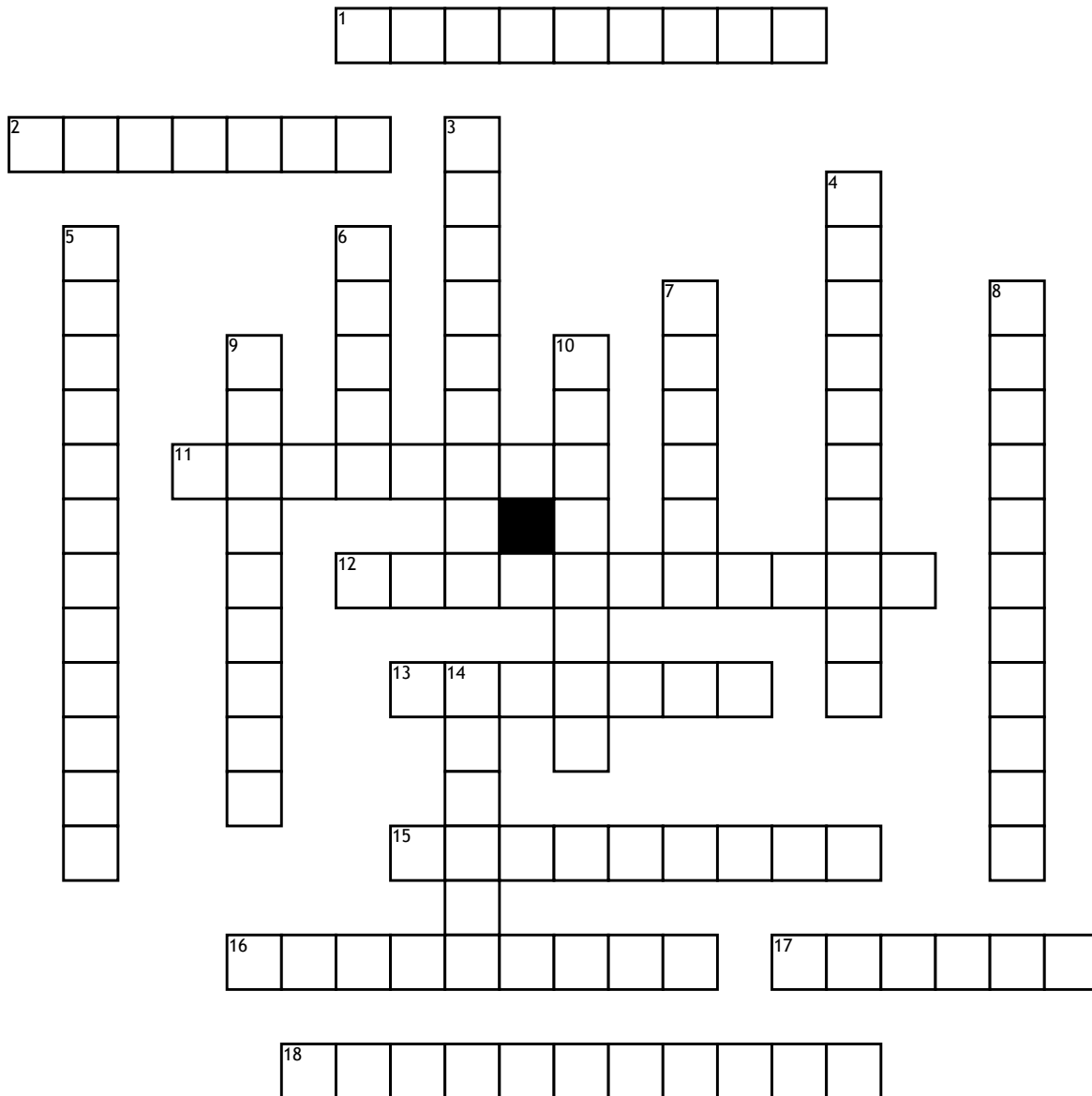


# BEDMAKING



## Across

1. this is a small, flat sheet that is placed over the middle of the bottom sheet; it covers the area of the bed from above the person's shoulders to below his buttocks  
 2. when a top sheet or blanket is turned back; bed is ready to receive a patient  
 11. may be white or colored, plain or print; this is a flat sheet  
 12. This is a thick layer of padding that is placed on the mattress to help make the bed more comfortable for the patient or resident, & to protect the mattress from moisture & soiling  
 13. may be woven cotton & should be available as requested by a person for his comfort

15. this adds the finishing touch to a well-made bed; adds a decorative touch to a person's room  
 16. placed over the middle of the bottom sheet to absorb extra moisture when a mattress pad is not used; may be used with turning or lifting a person  
 17. This is used for comfort & to aid in positioning  
 18. This may be used as a bottom sheet, & it fits snugly on mattress corners  
**Down**  
 3. this is used to help lift or reposition a person who needs assistance with moving in bed  
 4. Some facilities may call bed protectors THESE

5. This is a square of quilted absorbent fabric backed with waterproof material; also known as "soaker pad"  
 6. can rub the person's skin, causing irritation & leading to skin breakdown  
 7. sheets, mattress pads, pillow case, bedspread, etc  
 8. lightweight cotton blanket or flannel sheet that is used to provide modesty & warmth during a bed bath or a linen change  
 9. an empty bed  
 10. a way of folding & tucking the sheet so that it lies flat & neat against the mattress  
 14. you collect THESE in the order they will be used, then flip them
