

- **3.** Small woodwind instrument. Blow into different holes to produce different notes or chords.
- 5. Large instrument with many strings. Pluck each one to make a different note.
- **6.** Largest string instrument. Makes very low sounds.
- **11.** Small string instrument. Played with a bow.
- **14.** Woodwind instrument. Usually made of dark wood.
- **16.** This instrument group includes timpani, tambourines, triangles, and cymbals.

- **17.** Woodwind instrument. Common in Scotland.
- **18.** Keyboard instrument played with mallets.
- **19.** Large brass instrument. Makes very low sounds.
- **20.** Squeezed in and out. Buttons or keys on either end.

- 1. String instrument. Common in country and bluegrass music.
- **2.** Small string instrument. Picked or strummed.
- **4.** Large brass instrument. Move the slide to make different notes.

- 7. Large string instrument. Played with a bow. Usually, you sit down to play it.
- 8. 88 black and white keys.
- **9.** Woodwind instrument. Usually silver. Held sideways to play.
- **10.** String instrument. Common in rock music.
- **12.** Keyboard instrument common in churches.
- **13.** Usually round-shaped. Hit them with sticks or your hands to play.
- **15.** Common brass instrument. Makes higher sounds.
