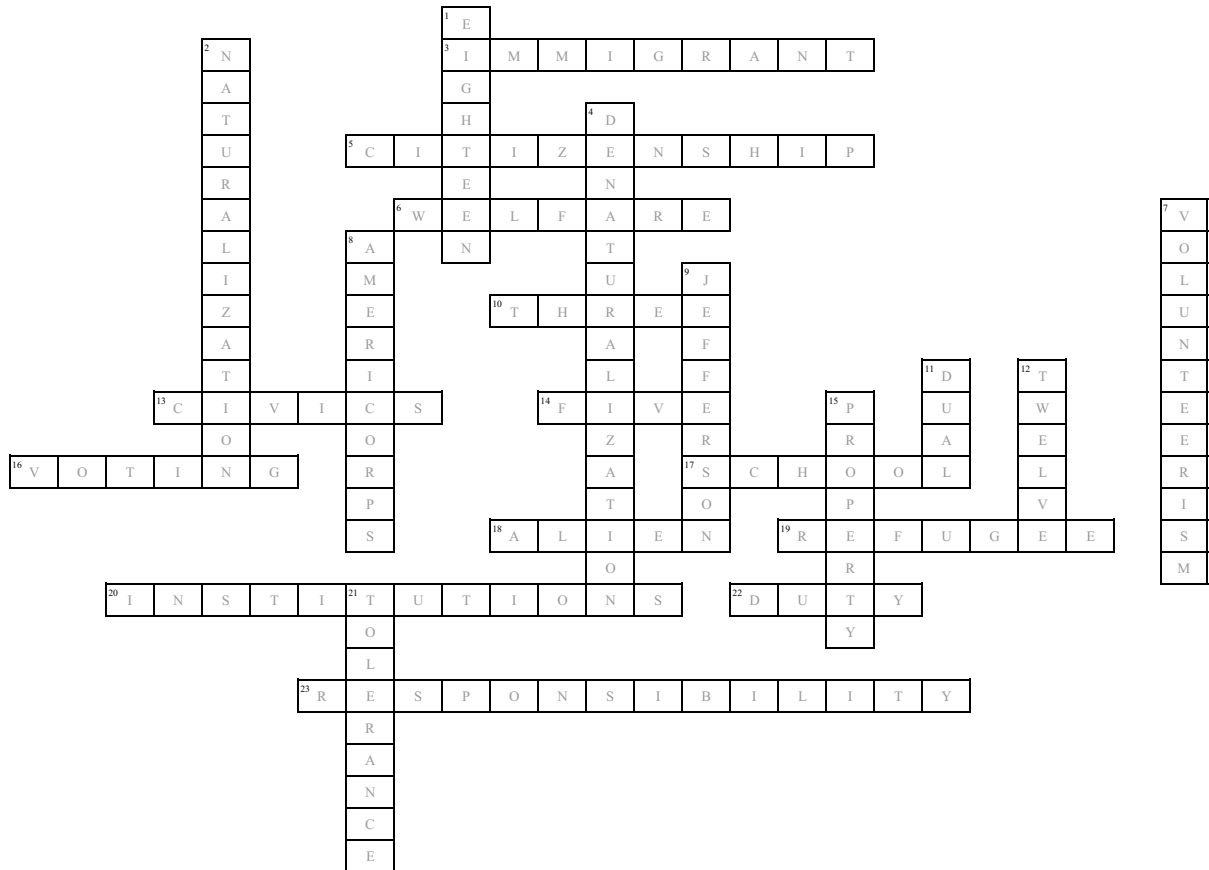


# Citizenship Crossword Puzzle
