1. one individual apartment ;large apartment building may contain 20 or more units. 3. services needed to make a house or apartment functional, such as hot water, electricity, natural gas, and cable and Internet service
2. rent and/or other charges are to be paid at such place or method designated by the OWNER
3. monthly income
4. length of a rental agreement, usually a period of one year
5. courtesy allows both parties time to make other arrangements
6. a legal document signed by both the tenant and the landlord that contains the terms of the agreement
