## Across

3. attaches presser foot to machine-button and can change easily to different feet
4. guide when making buttonholes
5. thread, fabric, and stitch must be set at its according tension.
6. holds needle in place
7. change stitch length and width
8. holds fabric against teeth
9. guides when winding bobbins

## Down

1. holds the top thread in place
2. controls movement of take up lever and needle
3. measurements help you sew straight and support fabric during sewing.
4. leads thread to a needle

## 6. Lowers and raises presser foot

7. is a disc that regulates tension for bobbin winding
8. locks stitches into place by stitching backwards 11. moves fabric along under presser foot
9. it controls the flow of the needle thread. Mus be properly threaded or the machine will not work.
