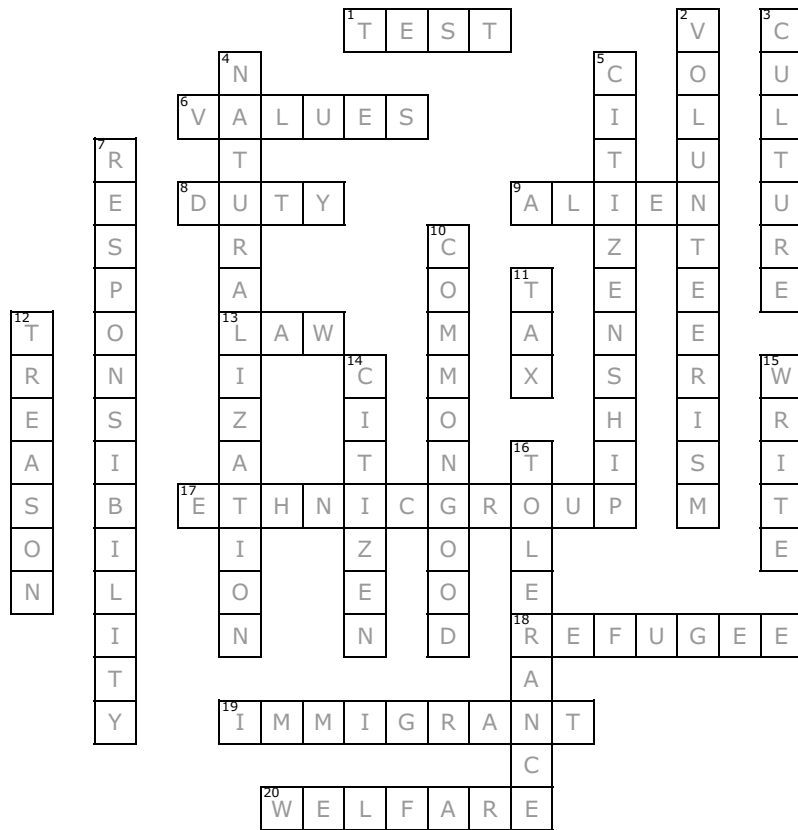


Citizenship Crossword Puzzle
