
## **Types Of Clouds**

**5.** High altitude clouds that are so thin they are only visible as a halo around the sun or moon.

**7.** Pouch-like clouds found underneath a thunderstorm when the storm weakening.

**8.** Low altitude clouds with flat bases and puffy tops indicating fair weather.

**1.** High altitude ice clouds with pachy or white puff and cover the sky in 24 hours
