

4. bowl-shaped hollow eroded by a glacier
 5. large hole that was eroded by a glacier the filled in with water when glacier melted
 8. a glacial trough formed by glacier scooping out the land
 10. sediment deposited where a river flows into an ocean
 12. narrow valley formed by a river coming down from mountains
 15. valley created by glacier now filled with sea water
 16. mound or ridge of sediment formed at edge of glacier

17. smaller river stream that flows into a main river
 18. long mound of till, or glacier deposits, smoothed in direction of glacial flow
 19. wide area of land along a river
 20. formed as a meander that has been cut off from a river

1. small depression left in till formed by melting ice
 2. erosion along cliffs on the edge of a flood plain
 3. a deposition of sand along a coastline where the speed of waves slow down

6. area of wave washed sediments along a coast
 7. sharp ridge separating two cirques
 9. loop-like bend in the source of a river
 11. a sharpened peak formed from glaciers descending from top of mountain
 13. The process by which water, ice, wind, or gravity moves fragments of rock and soil.
 14. formation left standing when a sea arch collapses
