

- 2. Tough connective tissue that connects bone to bone
- 3. Layers of broad flat tendons that connect muscle to muscle/bone
- **6.** Movement that brings palms up (or anterior)
- **8.** Main muscle responsible for a movement
- **9.** Movement that brings the dorsum of the foot up flex ankle
- 10. inflammation of a muscle
- 11. This reflex arc is stimulated by the L2, L3, L4 muscles and results in contraction of the quadriceps femoris muscle
- **12.** A disorder of the muscles

- **4.** Touch connective tissue that connects muscle to bone
