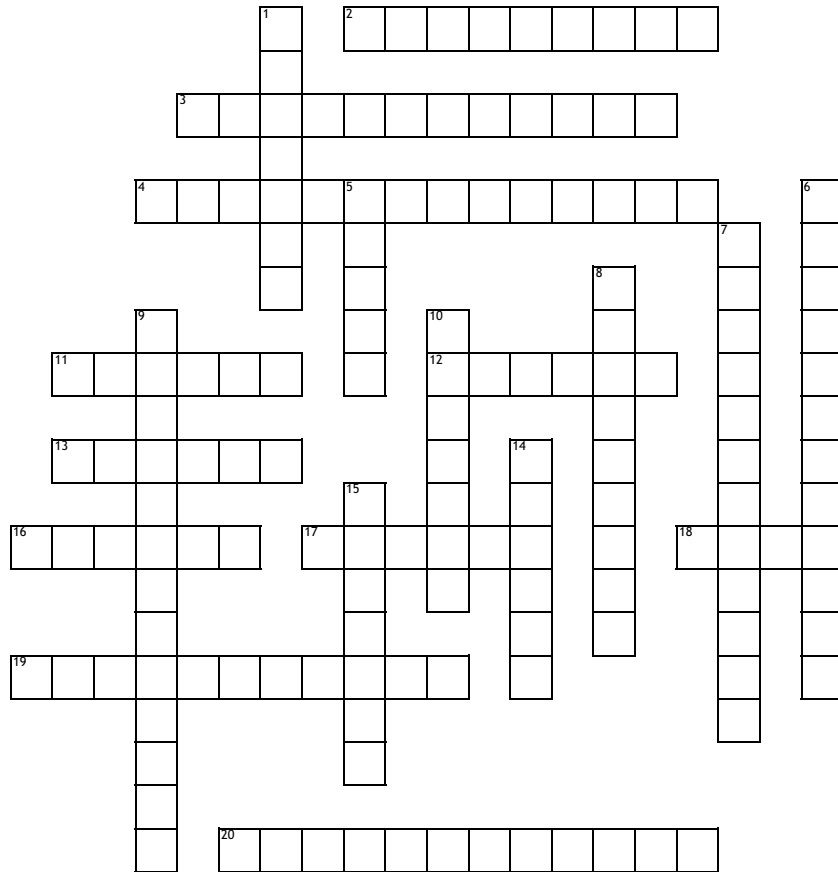


# Liturgical Year
