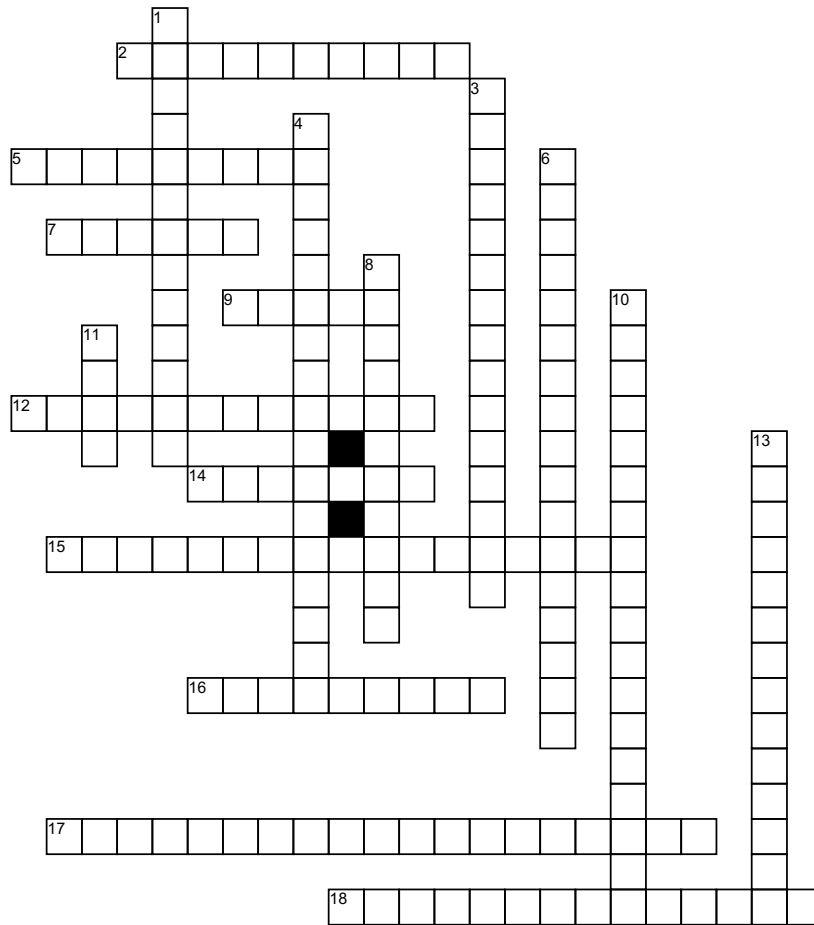


Exploration & Colonization crossword
